

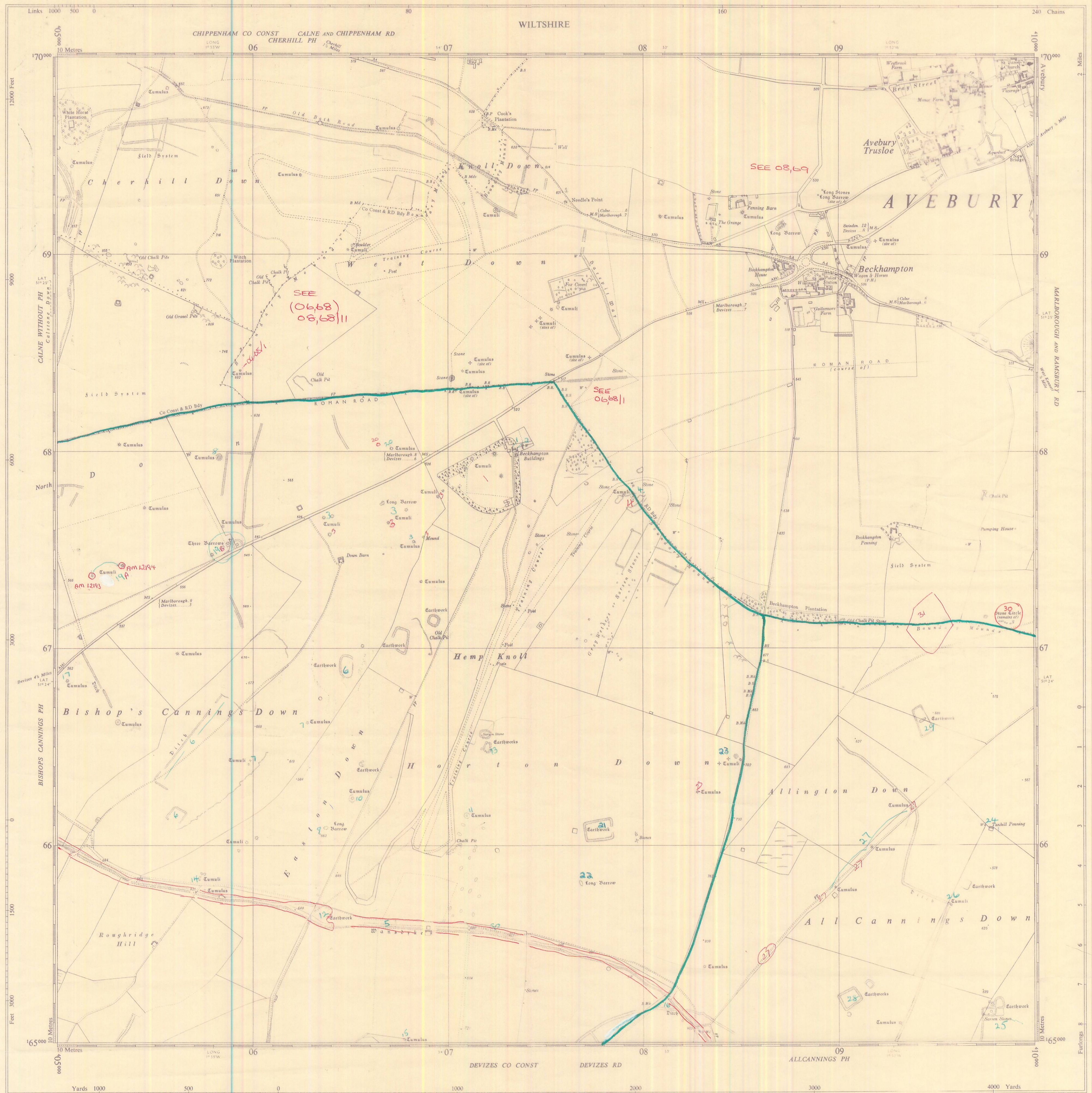

TO GIVE A GRID REFERENCE CORRECT TO 100 METRES	
EXAMPLE Down Barn

Take south edge of kilometre square in which point lies and read the larger figure printed opposite this line on north or west margin.	Take south edge of kilometre square in which point lies and read the larger figure printed opposite this line on east or west margin.

Full 100 Metre Reference SU 064674	
The above Full Reference is unique. For many purposes the first grid letter can be omitted, giving a reference, SU 064674, which refers to intervals of 100 Kilometres. If both grid letters are omitted, the resulting reference 064674 refers to intervals of 100 Kilometres. When the area concerned is sufficiently restricted, as will usually be the case with maps on scales of one inch to the mile and larger, both the grid letters are normally omitted.	
At the Eastern edge of this sheet True North is 1° 27' West of Grid North and at the Western edge 1° 13' West of Grid North.	
Magnetic North was above 10° West of Grid North in 1961, decreasing by about 1" in four years.	
Highways are in feet above Mean Sea Level as Newlyn.	
1 square inch on this map represents 17.75 acres on the ground.
