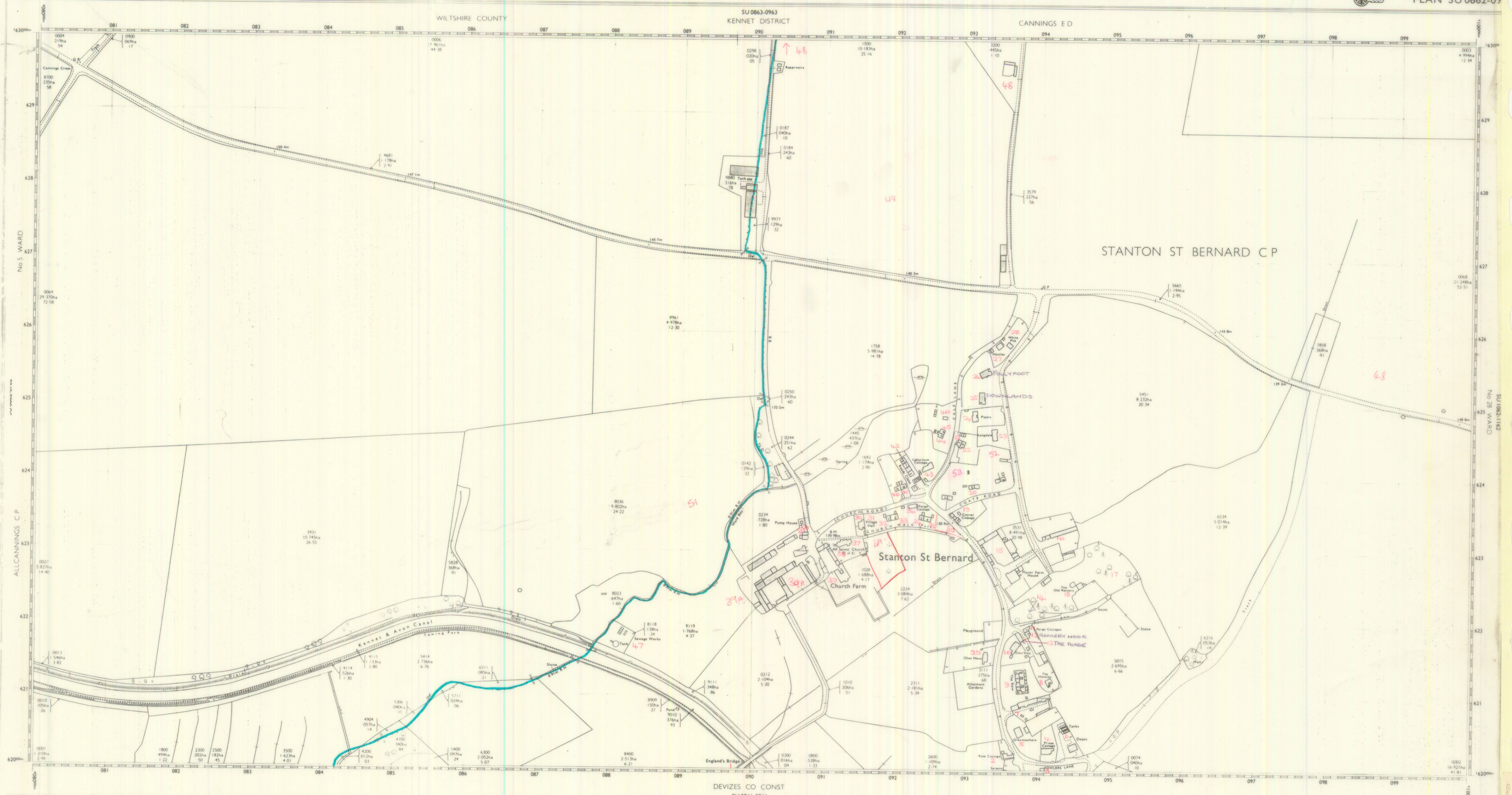

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the National Grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a unique reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows:

EXAMPLE: 425.7 291.4

425.7 = Easting (distance in metres from the grid line to the point, measured in the Easting direction)

291.4 = Northing (distance in metres from the grid line to the point, measured in the Northing direction)
