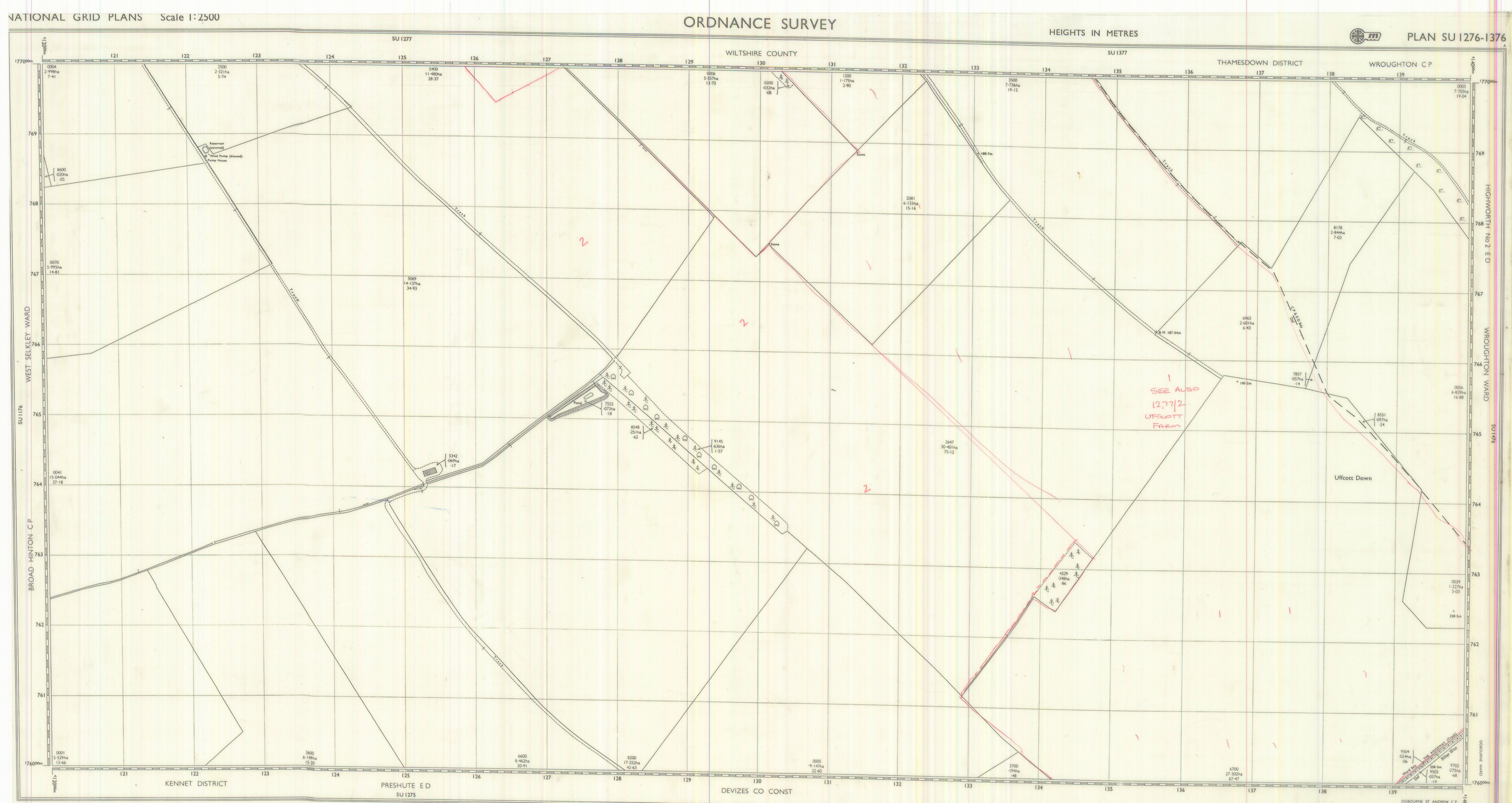

EXAMPLE from sheet TQ 0529

1. Take the two letters preceding the sheet number.....TQ

2. Take the west edge of the grid square in which the point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the north or south margin.....058

3. Take the south edge of the grid square in which the point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the east or west margin.....291

4. The resulting four figure number is the Easting.....0588

5. Estimate tenths of metres from the grid line to the point (distance N).....6

6. The resulting four figure number is the Northing.....2916

7. The full ten metre reference is given by writing first the Easting followed by the Easting and then by the Northing.....TQ 05882916
