When identifying a parcel it is important to specify the area in which the parcel is located. Enclosures or features placed for measurement of area, such as:

Limit of area within which all other features are shown

To convert hectares to acres multiply by 2.471
 To convert acres to hectares multiply by 0.40469

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form parts of the national grid and are 100 metre intervals. To give a reference defining the position of a point to within 100 metres proceed as follows—
