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When identifying a parcel it is important to indicate the following:

- Enclosure or features plotted for measurement
- Limit of area within which individual parcels are located
- To convert hectares to acres
- To convert acres to hectares

NATIONAL GRID

The grid lines form part of the National Grid and defining the position of a point to within 10 metres

1. Take the two letters preceding the sheet number
2. Take the east edge of the grid square in which you read the figure opposite this line on the scale
3. Estimate tens of metres from the grid line to the reading four figure number in the Eastings
4. Take the south edge of the grid square in which you read the figure opposite this line on the scale
5. Estimate tens of metres from the grid line to the reading four figure number in the Northings
6. The full ten metre reference is given by writing the Eastings and Northings together
