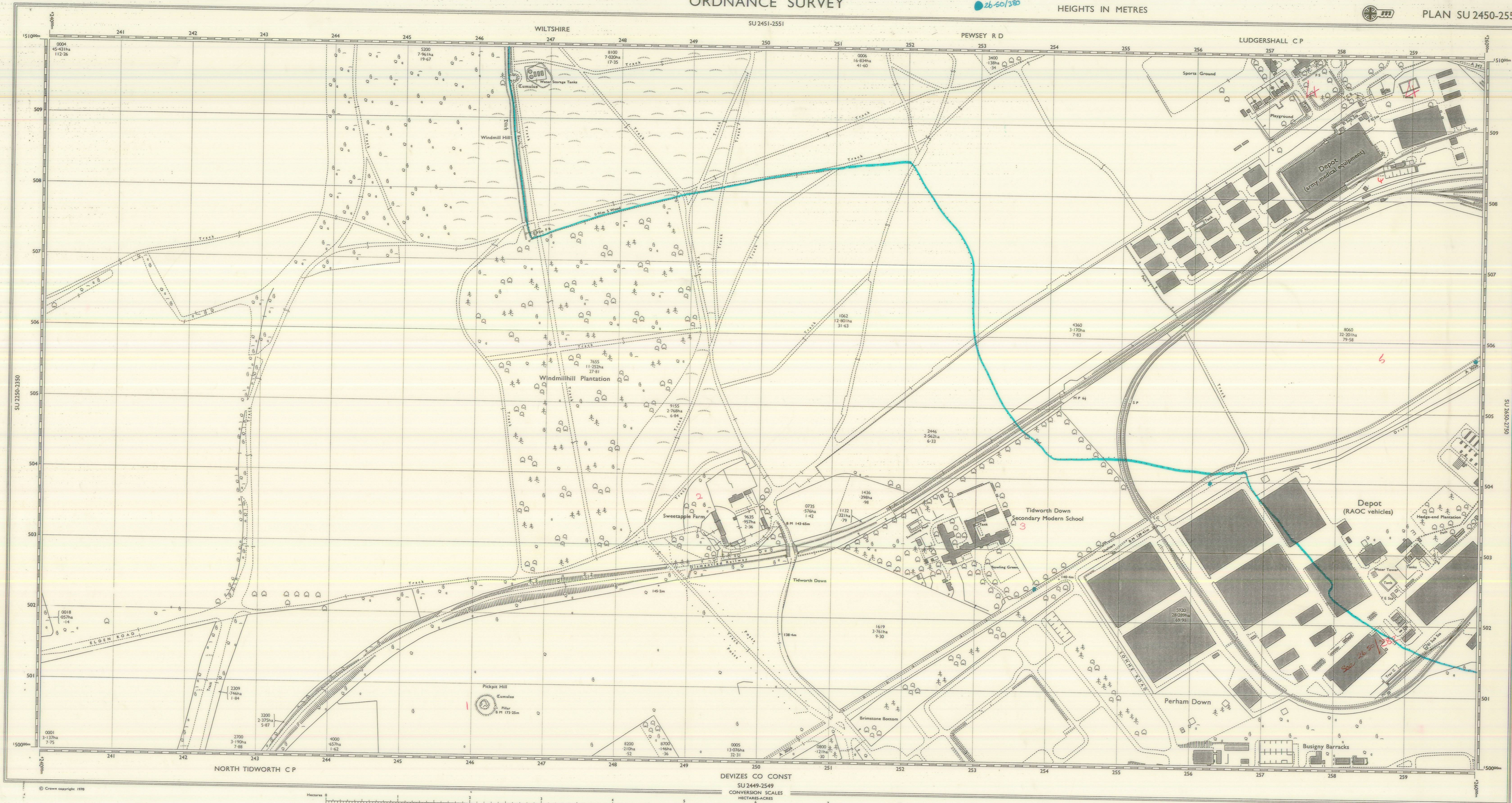

VEGETATION CLASSIFICATION

Where space permits, tree and scrub symbols in woods are shown in groups of four, three, two or singly to indicate close, medium, open or scattered density of trees or scrub.

AREAS

Area measurement is in square miles only.

The number and area, in hectares (ha) and acres, is shown within each parcel of land.

EXAMPLE: 1:2500 scale

When identifying a parcel it is important to specify the number of the plan on which it falls.

Boundaries or features joined for measurement of area.

Limit of area within which individual parcels are not shown.

To convert hectares to acres multiply by 2.47105.

To convert acres to hectares multiply by 0.4047.

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the National Grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows:-

EXAMPLE: 26 50 380

EASTING

Take west edge of 100-metre square in which point lies and read the figure opposite this line on the north or south margin.

NORTHING

Take south edge of 100-metre square in which point lies and read the figure opposite this line on the north or south margin.

Estimate tens of metres from grid line to the point.

Estimate units of metres from grid line to the point.
