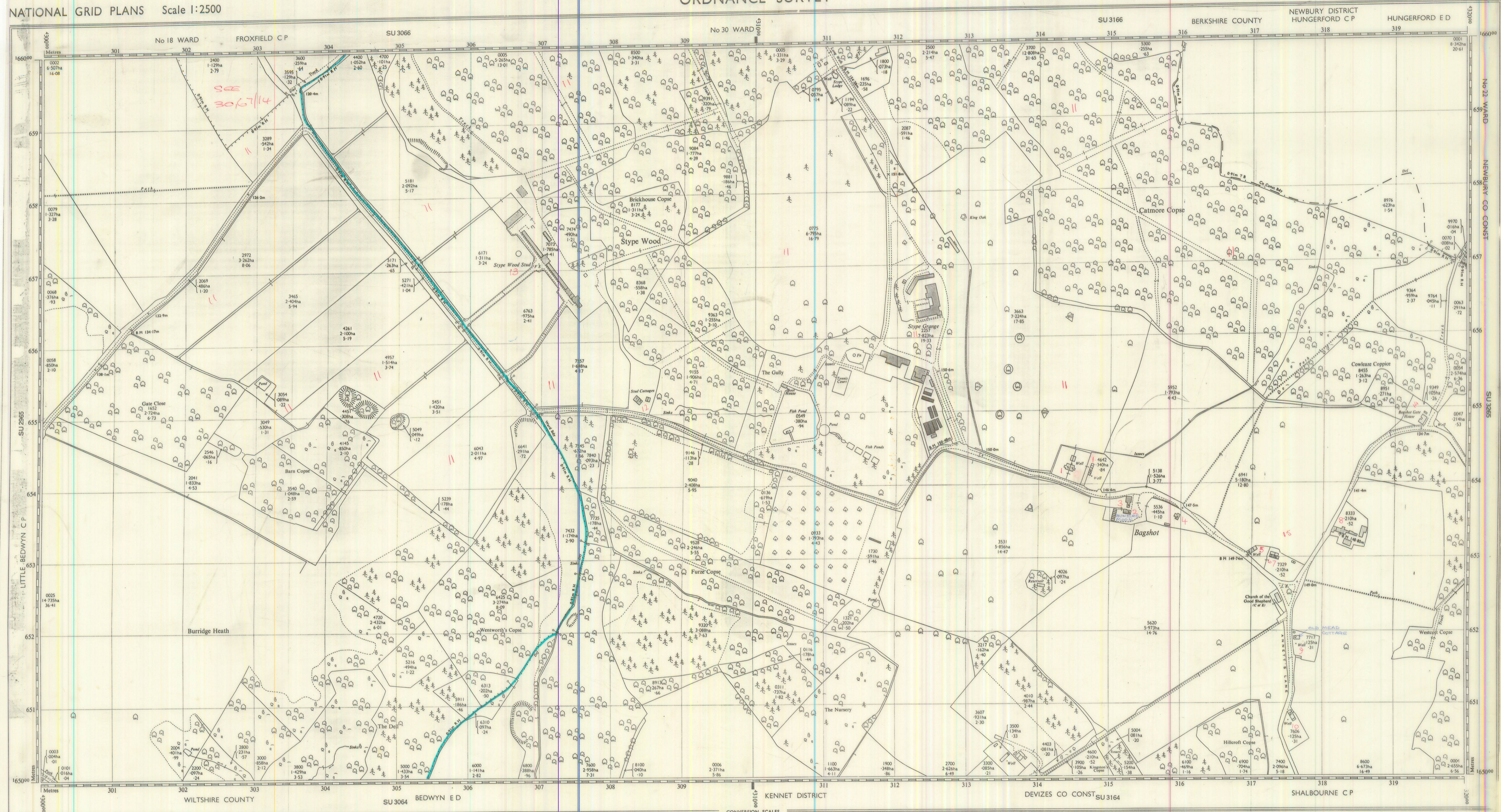

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the National Grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a unique reference to a point on the map, the grid reference is given by the letters of the grid square in which the point lies, followed by the Easting and then by the Northing. To convert grid reference to Easting and Northing, see the National Grid Reference System.
