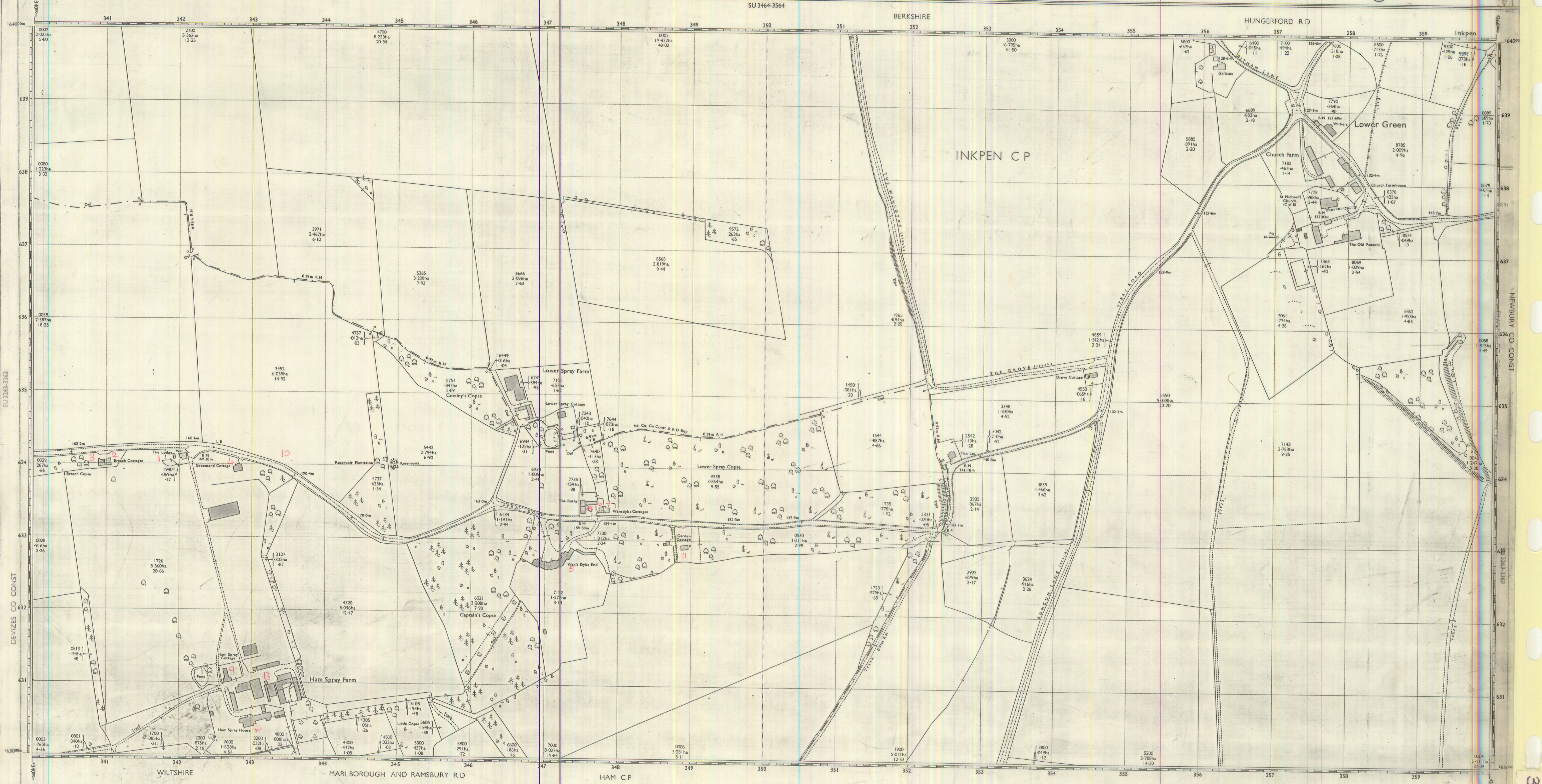

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the national grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows:

EASTING

Take west edge of 100 metre square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the north or south margin.

NORTHING

Take south edge of 100 metre square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the north or south margin.

Estimate tens of metres from grid line to the point.

EXAMPLE: R in THE DROVE (track)

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CONVERSION SCALES

1 metre = 3.2808 feet

1 foot = 0.3048 metres

VEGETATION CLASSIFICATION

Where space permits, tree and scrub symbols in woods are shown in groups of four, three, two or singly to indicate close, medium, open or scattered density of trees or scrub.
