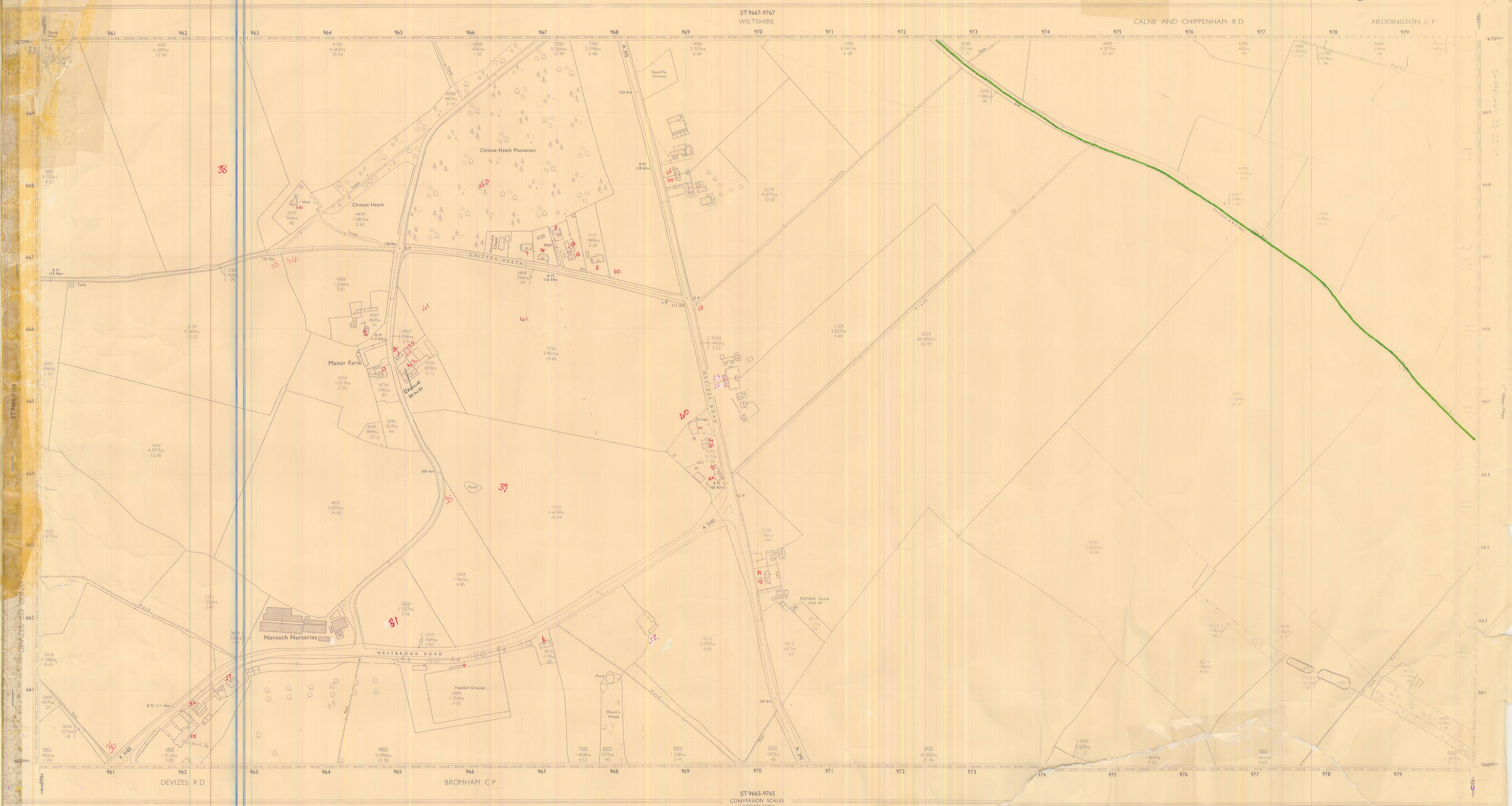

AREAS

Area measurement is to plan edge only. The number and area in hectares (ha) and acres (a) are shown within each parcel of land.

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the national grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows—

EASTING

Take the edge of 100 metres square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the east or west margin. Estimate tens of metres from grid line to the point.

NORTHING

Take the edge of 100 metres square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the north or south margin. Estimate tens of metres from grid line to the point.
