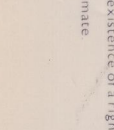

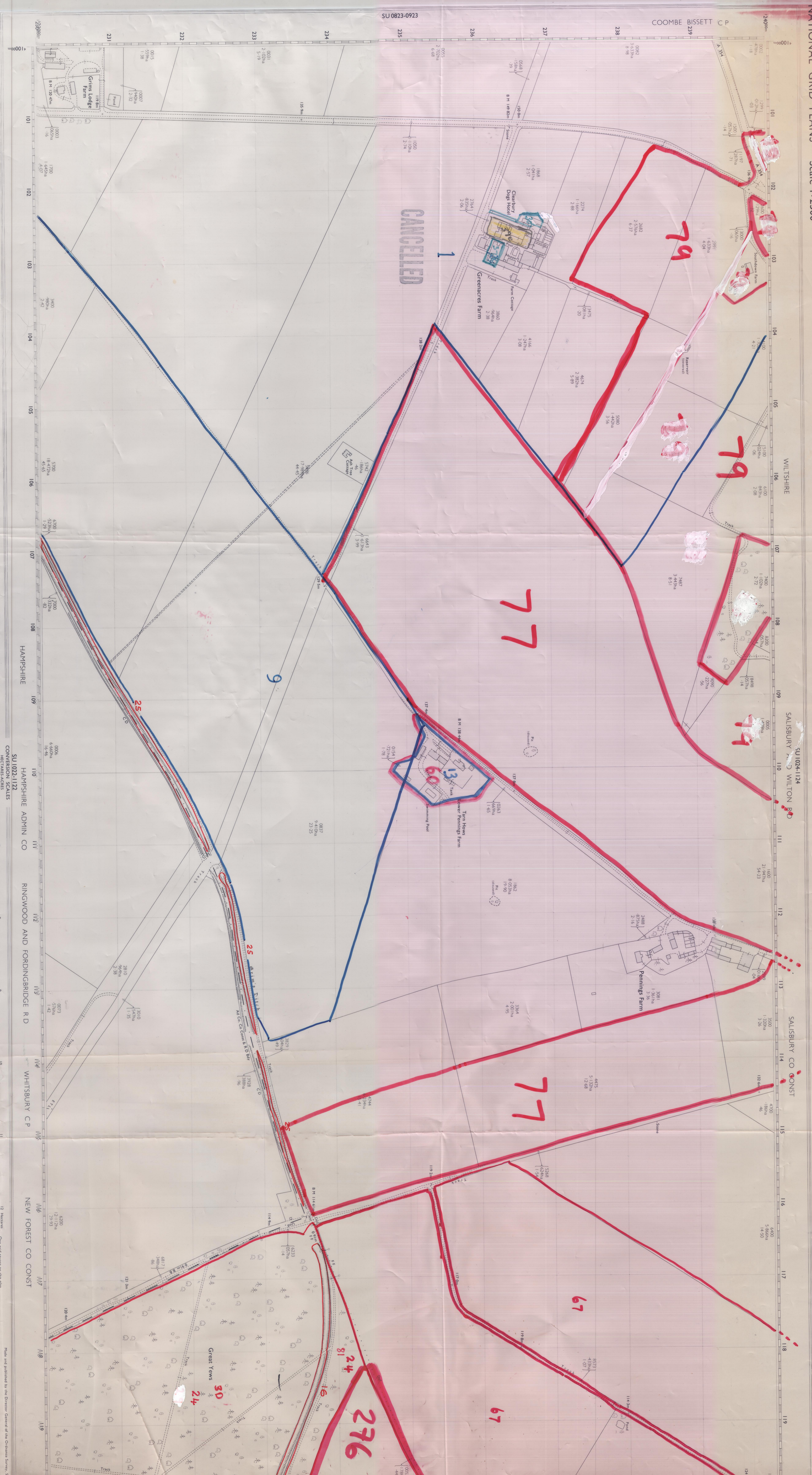

The grid lines are marked every 100 metres. The first reference indicates the number of 100 metres in the easting and the second the number of 100 metres in the northing.
