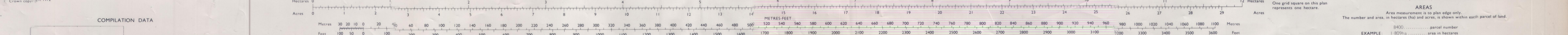

SYMBOLS:

Non-coniferous Trees, Coniferous Trees, Surveyed Trees, Orchard Trees, Coppice, Osier, Scrub, Bracken, Heath, Rough Grassland, Marsh, Spings, Reeds

Vegetation Classification: Where open perennials, tree and scrub symbols in woods are shown in groups of four, three, two or singly to indicate close, medium, open or scattered density of trees or scrub.

BOUNDARIES:

England & Wales: County Boundary (geographical), County & Civil Parish Boundary, Admin. County or County Borough Boundary, London Borough Boundary, County District Boundary, Civil Parish Boundary, Pary & Ward Boundary (based on civil parish), Borough, U.D. Bd., R.D. Bd., Co. Const Bd., Pary & Ward Boundary (not based on civil parish), Where the boundary of an Admin. Co. County Borough, or Co. of City is coincident with that of a geographical county, the symbol for that county is shown.

Scotland: County Boundary (geographical), County Council Boundary, County of the City Boundary, Burgh Boundary, District Boundary, District Council Boundary.

Examples of Boundary Merings: C.R. Centre of Road, sec. R.H. Road or Hedge, C.C.S. Centre of Covered Stream, C.D. Centre of Drain, etc. E.K. Edge of bank, Imperial Equivalents for Metric Boundary Merings (0.914m, 3ft, 1.22m, 4ft).

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE: The grid lines form part of the National Grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres, proceed as follows - Example: 758 238 (Easting and Northing). Take west edge of 100 metre square in which point lies and read the figure opposite this line on the east or west margin. Estimate area of metres from grid line to the point. Take south edge of 100 metre square in which point lies and read the figure opposite this line on the east or west margin. Estimate area of metres from grid line to the point.
