VEGETATION CLASSIFICATION: Where appropriate, trees and scrub symbols in woods are shown in groups of four, three, two or singly to indicate class, medium, open or scattered density of trees or scrub.

AREAS

Area measurement is to plan edge only.
Enclosures or features used for measurement of area.
The number and area, in hectares (ha) and acres, is shown within each parcel of land.

EXAMPLE: 4207 parcel number
1.807ha area in hectares
4.47 area in acres

When identifying a parcel it is important to specify the number of the plan on which it falls.
Enclosures or features used for measurement of area.
Limit of area within which individual parcels are not shown.

To convert hectares to acres multiply by 2.471 05
To convert acres to hectares multiply by 0.404 69

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the national grid and are 100 metres intervals. To give a reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows -

EXAMPLE: H in Hare Covert
