**NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE**

The grid lines form part of the national grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows—

**EXAMPLE**

EASTING	219	358
NORTHING	1358	1358

To convert hectares to acres multiply by 2.471 05  
 To convert acres to hectares multiply by 0.404 69

**VEGETATION CLASSIFICATION:** Where space permits, tree and scrub symbols in woods are shown in groups of four: three, one or singly to indicate close, medium, open or scattered density of trees or scrub.

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
