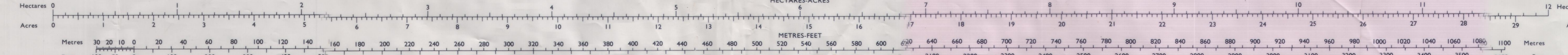

ABBREVIATIONS

Table of abbreviations for various features like Beer House, Bench Mark, Boundary Stone, etc.

SYMBOLS

Table of symbols for features like Non-coniferous trees, Coniferous trees, Surveyed trees, etc.

BOUNDARIES

Table of boundary symbols for England & Wales and Scotland, including County, Civil Parish, and Burgh boundaries.

AREAS

Area measurement is in plan edge only. The number and area, in hectares (ha) and acres, is shown within each parcel of land.

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the National Grid and are at 10 metre intervals. To give a unique reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows:
