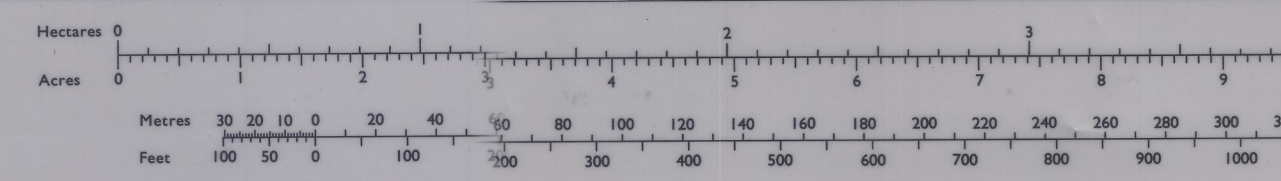

Table of BOUNDARIES. Lists boundaries for England & Wales (Administrative County, County Borough, etc.) and Scotland (Burgh, County Council, etc.).

Table of NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE. Explains how to use the grid to find a point, with an example showing coordinates 291 291.

VEGETATION CLASSIFICATION. Where special permits, trees and scrub symbols in woods are shown in groups of four, three, two or singly to indicate dense, medium, open or scattered density of trees or scrub.
