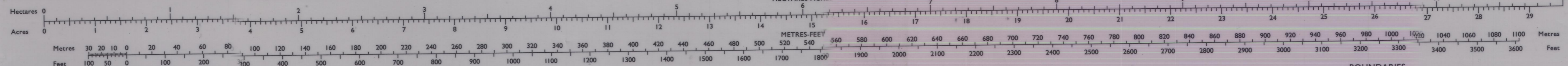

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE
The grid lines form part of the National Grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a unique reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows:

EXAMPLE: 10797ha 44.38
4267 parcel number
1:8797ha area in hectares
4.47 area in acres

Where space permits, rose and scrub symbols in woods are shown in groups of four, three, two or singly to indicate close, medium, open or scattered density of trees or scrub.
