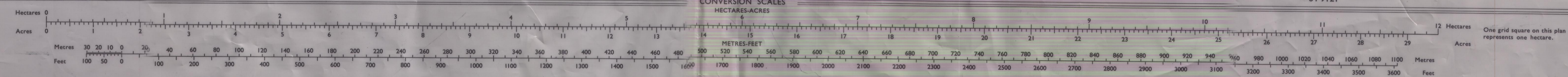

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE
 The grid lines form part of the National Grid and are at 100 metres intervals. To give a unique reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows:
 EXAMPLE: 4267 1809
 4267.....parish number
 1809ha.....area in hectares
 4267 1809ha.....area in acres
 To convert hectares to acres multiply by 2.47105
 To convert acres to hectares multiply by 0.40469
