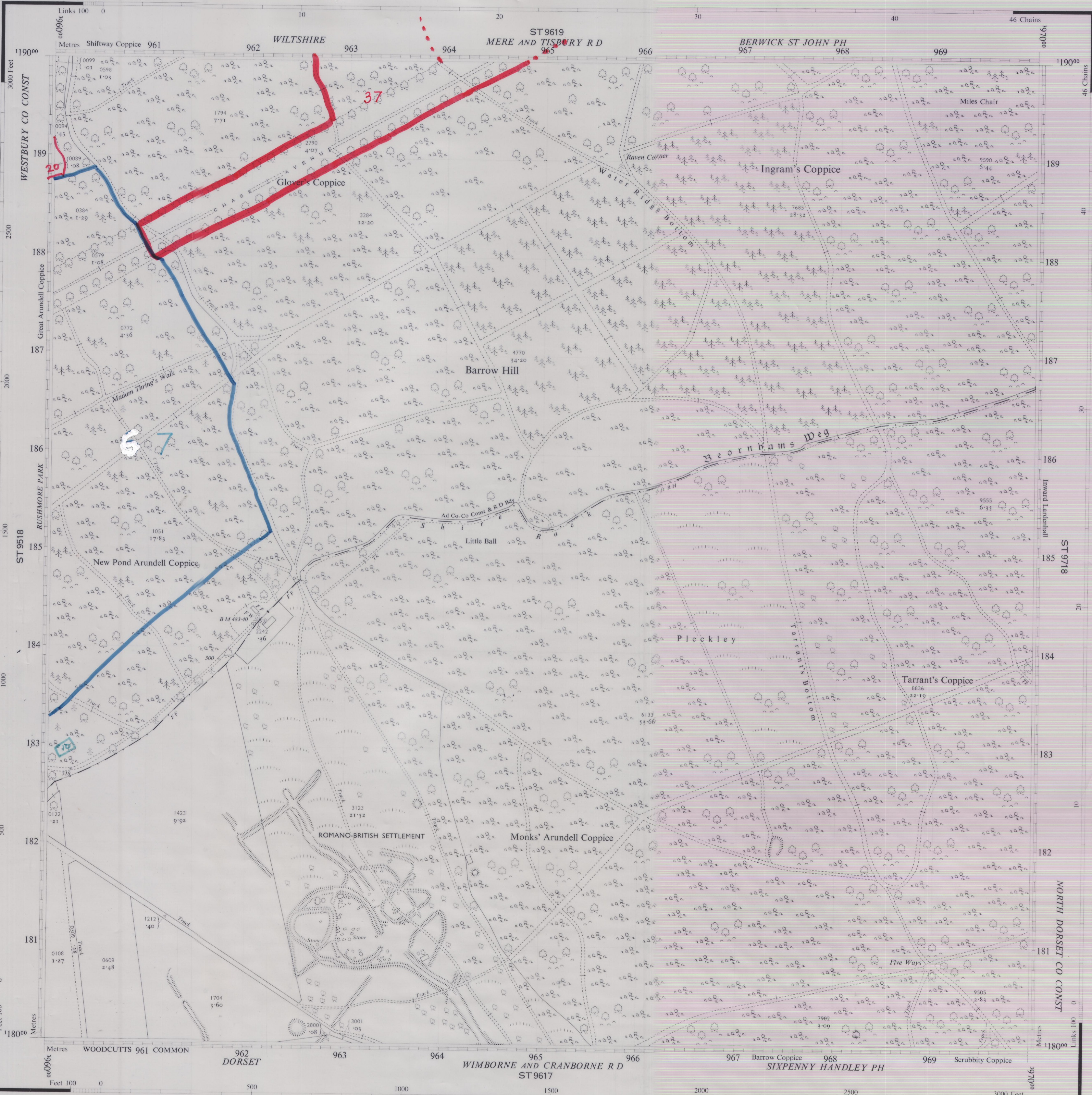

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The lines on the plan form part of the National Grid and are spaced at 100 metre intervals. To give a large scale reference defining the position of a point to the nearest 10 metres proceed as follows:

EXAMPLE: L in Little Ball	
EASTING	NORTHING
Take west edge of square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on NORTH and SOUTH margins	Take south edge of square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on EAST and WEST margins

The representation on this plan of a road, track or footpath is no evidence of the existence of a right of way.

- Antiquities: Site of (cross), Change of boundary mering (dashed line), Perimeter of built up area (dotted line)
- Bench Mark: Fundamental (circle with cross), Stable (circle with dot)
- Surface Level: Revision Point (circle with cross), Triangulation Station (triangle)
- Levelling Information: Altitudes of Bench Marks and surface levels are given in feet above the Newlyn Datum. Bench Mark lists, which may contain later levelling information, are obtainable from Director General, Ordnance Survey.
- Boundary Mering Abbreviations: BB (Centre of Bank), CB (Centre of Canal, etc.), CC (Centre of Stream), CD (4 feet from Root of Hedge), CCS (Face of Fence)
- Face of Wall (FW), Side of River, etc (SR), Track of Hedge (TK H), Track of Stream (TK S), Defaced, Undeline (Def, Und)

- Beer House (BH), Bench Mark (BM), Boundary Post (BP), Boundary Stone (BS), Captain, Crane (CC), Cart Track (CT), Drinking Fountain (DF), Electricity Pillar, Post or Pylon (EPP), Fire Alarm Pillar (FAP), Flagstaff (FS), Foot Bridge (FB), Footpath (FP), Fundamental Bench Mark (FBM), High or Low Water Mark of Medium Tides (H or LWMT)
- Guide Post (GP), Letter Box (LB), Level Crossing (LC), Mile or Mooring Post (MP), Mile Stone (MS), Pillar, Pole, Post or Pylon (PP), Police Call Box (PCB), Post Office (PO), Public House (PH), Pump (Pp), Revision Point (rp), Signal Box (SB), Signal Bridge (SBr), Signal Post (SP), Spring (Spr), Stone (S), Sundial (SD), Tank or Track (TK), Telephone Call Box (TCB), Trough (Tr), Water Point (Wp), Water Tap (WT), Weighbridge (WB), Well (W), Wind Pump (Wp)
- High or Low Water Mark Ordinary Spring Tides (H or LWMOST)
