
Schedule 3 - Steps required to be taken

- 1. Cease the use of the land for the stationing of a mobile home.
- 2. Remove from the land the said mobile home and all buildings, structures and means of enclosure on the land, and the resultant spoil and waste.
- 3. Restore those parts of the land forming part of the public highway, shown cross-hatched on the attached plan, to a condition suitable for its use as public highway.
- 4. Restore the remainder of the land to a condition suitable for agricultural cultivation.

Reason

1. This development is located in a predominantly rural area and outside any settlement framework boundary; and its continued existence is detrimental to the appearance and character of the area contrary to the land use and rural amenity policies and objectives of the Development Plan (North East Wiltshire Structure Plan alterations 1 and 2, policies H19, H24 and C10); North Wiltshire Local Plan, policies H10, H13 and C7 and the North Wiltshire Local Plan Review, policies RH11, RH16 and RC9. No evidence of any particular or exceptional case of need for the development has been advanced; and there are no "other material considerations" to outweigh the objections referred to.
