The statutory grounds of appeal available are set out in Section 39 of the Act, which I copy to you. Any appeal should have with it the extra copy of the Notice that I have provided. AN APPEAL SHOULD BE RECEIVED BY THE PLANNING INSPECTORATE BEFORE THE NOTICE TAKES EFFECT.

There is a requirement on the Council to specify the reasons why the local planning authority consider it expedient to issue the Notice and these reasons are set out in the Notice.

#### SCHEDULE 1 - LISTED BUILDING TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES

The building known as the Coach House, the Mount House, Great Somerford, Wiltshire ("the building") shown shaded grey on the attached plan, being within the curtilage of the listed building known as the Mount House, aforesaid.

#### **SCHEDULE 2 - THE CONTRAVENTION**

- 1. The unauthorised subdivision of the first floor window of the west elevation of the building into small panes with horizontal proportions to glazed panes.
- 2. The unauthorised replacement of the windows above the former stable doors on the east elevation of the building with sash windows, each subdivided into small panes with horizontal proportions to glazed panes.
- 3. The unauthorised insertion on the east elevation ground floor main range of a window detailed with fixed light and heavy upper rail and with an inward-opening hopper to the upper section.


#### SCHEDULE 3 - STEPS REQUIRED TO BE TAKEN

- 1. Remove all glazing bars from the first floor window of the west elevation, as detailed in paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 above, and reglaze with a single pane of glass to each casement.
- 2. Redetail the glazing pattern of the east elevation window above the former stable doors, as detailed in paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 above, by the omission of the horizontal glazing bars.
- 3. Replace the window on the east elevation ground floors main range, detailed in paragraph 3 of Schedule 2 above, with a double-hung sash window, detailed to match the first floor east elevation windows, but with the pattern amended from 8 over 8 to 10 over 10 panes, and with subcill flush with the outer frame of the window.

TIME LIMIT - WITHIN THE PERIOD OF THREE MONTHS FROM THE DATE ON WHICH THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT.
