2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

Land at The Stores, Bowds Lane, Brinkworth, Chippenham, Wiltshire ("the Land") shown shaded grey on the attached plan

3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

- 1. The unauthorised use of the site and premises as a depot and centre of operations for a taxi business, and also as a commercial vehicle parking area, both in addition to the lawful use of the existing building on the site as a store within Use Class B8.
- 2. The erection of a two-way radio mast on the north-west end elevation of the main building used in connection with the taxi business.

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- 1. It appears to the Council that the above breaches of planning control have occurred within the last ten and four years respectively.
- The developments are contrary to the provision of the local development plan (The North East Wiltshire Structure Plan, policies E11, E13 and C6; The North Wiltshire Local Plan, policies E15, E16 and C7; and the North Wiltshire Local

Plan Review (as modified up to the conclusion of its Public Inquiry in February 1997,) policies RE19 and RC9) and as such would frustrate its land use, rural amenity and transport objectives, contrary to the public interest.

- 3. The developments appear incongruous within, and are detrimental to, the rural character and appearance of the local environment.
- 4. The unclassified and Class III roads serving the site and local area are narrow and winding with sections of poor horizontal and vertical alignment, and are unsuitable to safely and conveniently cater for the additional traffic movements which are generated by the use of the site as a taxi-hire depot and office.
- 5. The junction of Bowds Lane with the A3012 has substandard width, radii and visibility; and the development results in increased use of this junction to the detriment of highway safety on the Class 1 road.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- 1. Remove the aerial from the land.
- 2. Cease the taxi business and commercial vehicle parking uses and activities on the land.

6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

Three months from the date this Notice takes effect.

7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 27 May 1998 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

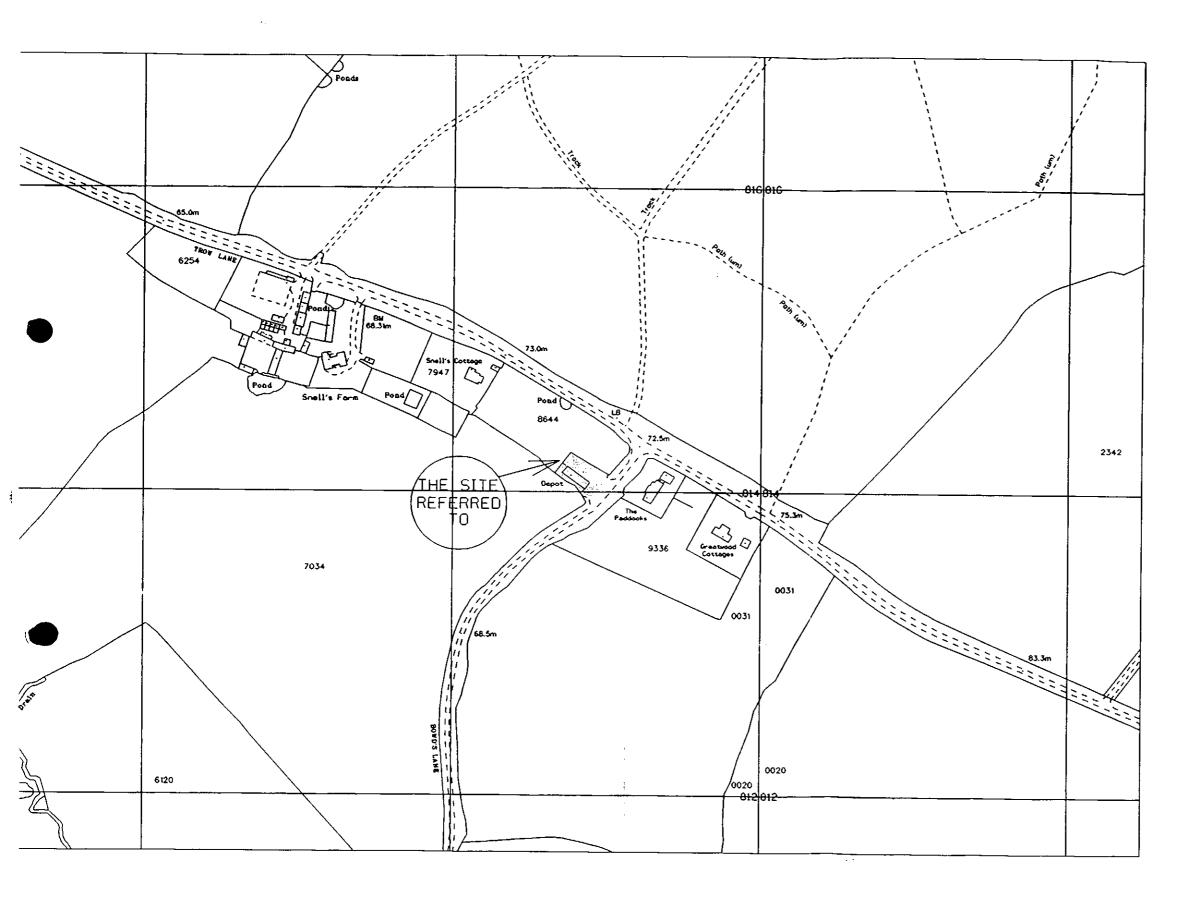

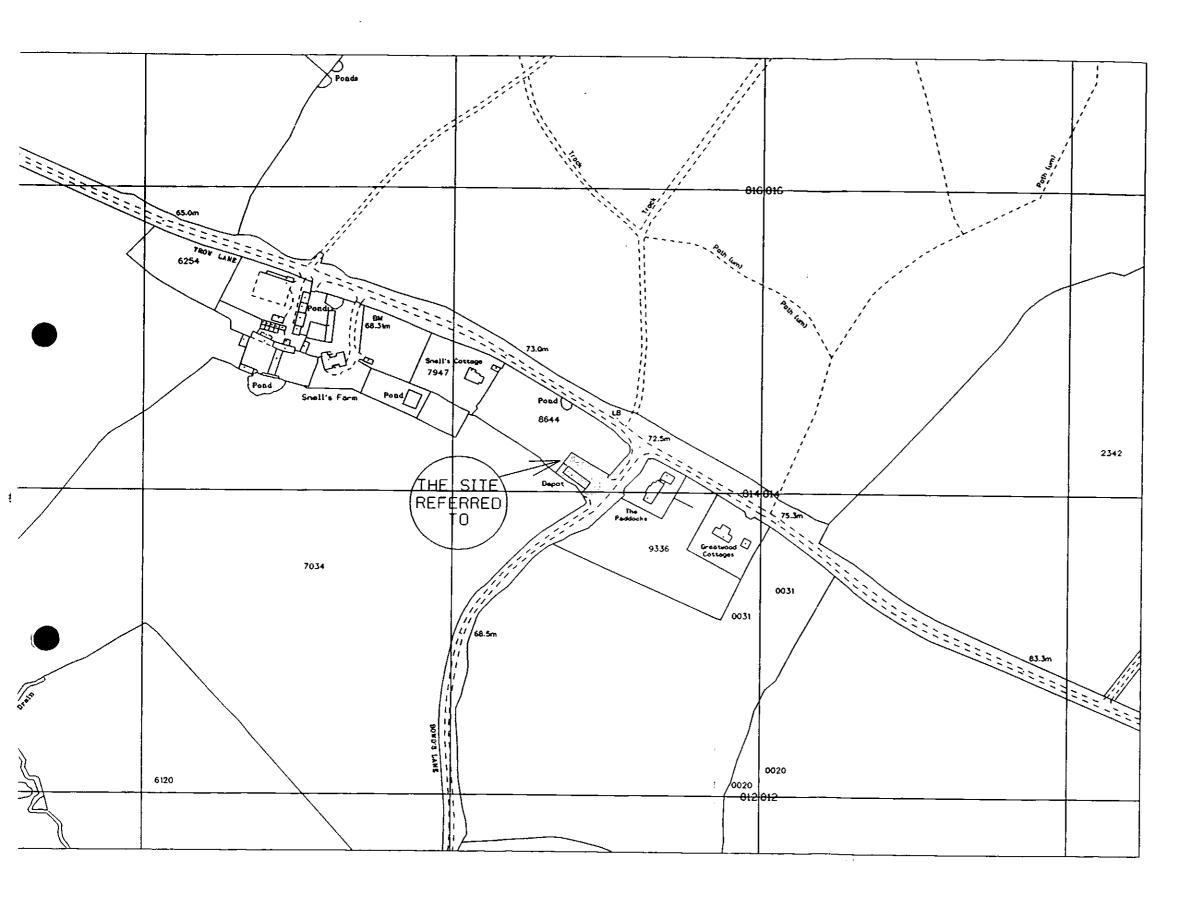

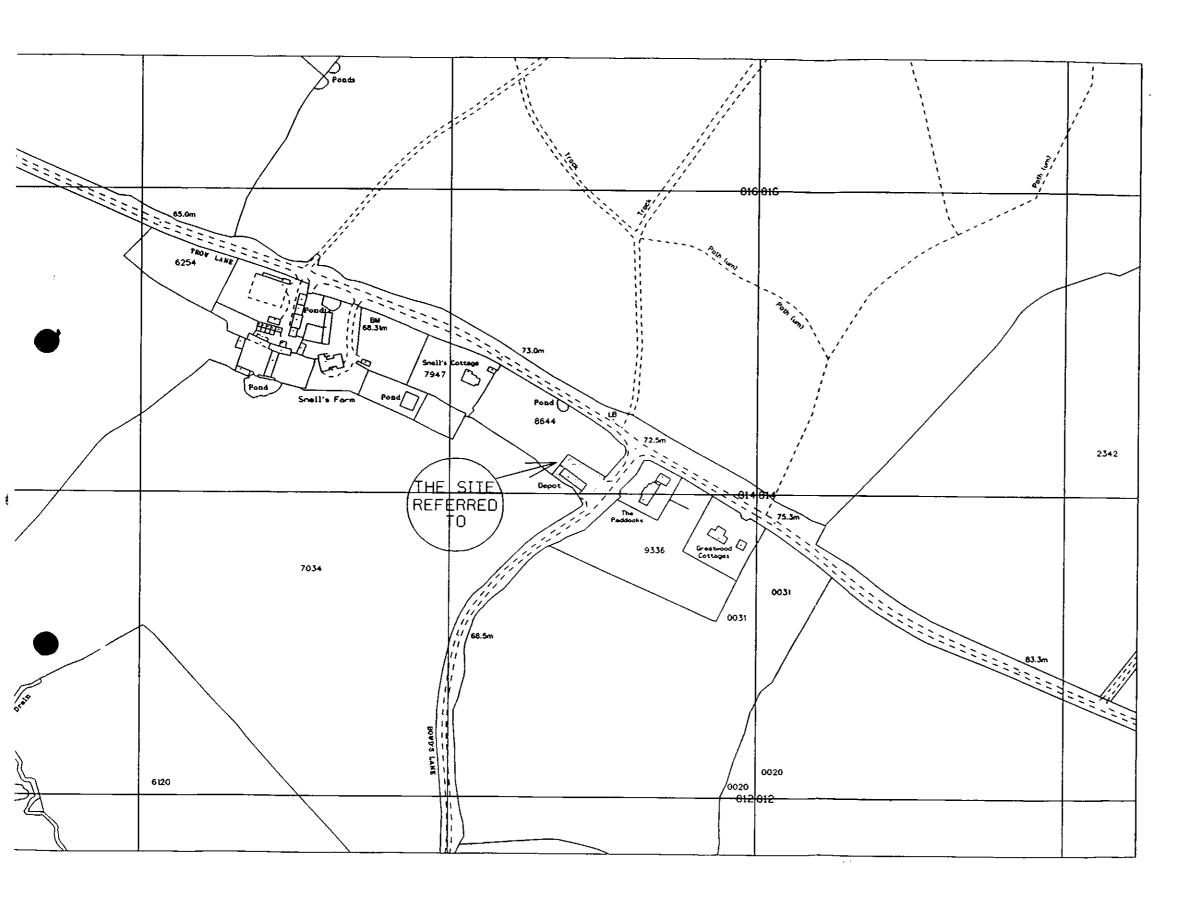
