ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

ISSUED BY: North Wiltshire District Council

1. THIS NOTICE is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, within paragraph (a) of section 171A(1) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

Land at The Stables, Ashes Lane, Kington Langley, Wiltshire shown edged red on the attached plan.

3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission, change of use of the Land from use for equestrian purposes to a mixed use as a wildlife rescue centre/menagerie and for the siting and storage of residential caravans and associated vehicles and trailers.

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last ten years. It is considered that the erection of substantial cages/enclosures adversely affects the established character and amenity of the Kington Langley Conservation Area and would not accord with the provision of Policy C2 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan as amended and revised by Policy RC3 of the emerging North Wiltshire Local Plan Review. It is considered that the erection of substantial cages/enclosures, beyond the Village Limit for Kington Langley, as defined in the

North Wiltshire Local Plan, is to the detriment of the rural character and amenity of an attractive area of open countryside and would be contrary to the provision of Policy C7, as amended by Policy RC3, which seeks to preserve and enhance the character and appearance of rural areas.

It is considered that siting or storage of residential caravans and associated vehicles and trailers in immediate proximity to dwellings adversely affects the residential amenity of the area.

It is considered that planning permission has already been granted for living accommodation to supervise the authorised use of the land and that siting of additional residential caravans is tantamount to the creation of two additional units of residential accommodation. These cannot be justified as being essential at this location and are to the detriment of the established character and amenity of the Kington Langley Conservation Area and the surrounding countryside. The development would not therefore accord with Policies H13, C7 and B2 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan as endorsed and amended by Policies RH15, RC9 and RB3 of the emerging North Wiltshire Local Plan Review which seek to discourage non-essential development and to protect, preserve and enhance the quality of Conservation Areas and the Countryside.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- 1. Cease use of the Land for the siting and/or storage of residential caravans and remove all such caravans and associated vehicles and trailers from the Land.
- Stop allowing general public access onto the Land, whether or not by payment of an admission fee for viewing of animals or for any associated leisure purpose.
- 3. Cease use of the Land for any purpose connected with the care, keeping and/or display of any species of animal for which a Licence would be required under the provisions of the Dangerous Wild Animals Act 1976 (as amended) and any amendment thereof.
- 4. Remove all cages and any other structure over 1 metre in height (other than boundary fences) designed to contain or prevent the escape of animals.
- 5. Re-seed the area of the Land shown stippled on the attached plan using an agricultural grass seed mixture and restore the said area to pasture suitable for the grazing of livestock.

7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT


YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

If you do not appeal against this enforcement notice, it will take effect on the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice and you must then ensure that the required steps for complying with it, for which you may be held responsible, are taken within the period specified in paragraph 6 of the notice. Failure to comply with an enforcement notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.






