If you wish to appeal against the Notice, you or your agent should complete the Appeal Form and send it to the Planning Inspectorate, Room 11/11(7), Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol BS2 9DJ setting out the grounds of your appeal and, in brief, the facts on which you rely for support. The Council will also require a copy of the completed form. The statutory grounds of appeal available are set out in Section 39 of the Act, which I copy to you. Any appeal should have with it the extra copy of the Notice that I have provided. AN APPEAL SHOULD BE RECEIVED BY THE PLANNING INSPECTORATE BEFORE THE NOTICE TAKES EFFECT.

There is a requirement on the Council to specify the reasons why the local planning authority consider it expedient to issue the Notice and these reasons are set out in the Notice.

#### SCHEDULE 3 - REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

It is considered that the removal of the traditional timber windows and their replacement with UVPC framed windows adversely affects the character and appearance of the Category-II Listed Building, and is not in accordance Policy RB12 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan Review, which seeks to protect, preserve and enhance the architectural character and historic importance of Listed Buildings.

#### SCHEDULE 4 - STEPS REQUIRED TO BE TAKEN TO REMEDY THE BREACH

- 1. Remove the UPVC windows that have been installed in the front (road-facing) elevation of the Listed Building.
- 2. Fit each window opening in the front elevation of the Listed Building with traditionally detailed timber windows to the same design and specification that existed at 56 Marshfield Road prior to the installation of the unauthorised UVPC windows.
