On 14 July 1992 planning permission was granted by the Secretary of State under reference N.91.1736.F for residential development, subject to conditions. One of those conditions (Condition No.3) provided as follows:

"Notwithstanding the provisions of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 (or any order revoking and re-enacting that order), there shall be no gates, fences, walls, new buildings, structures or external alterations to any part of the development ...".

It appears to the Council that the condition has not been complied with, in that a fence has been erected in the position shown by a heavy black line and marked "Line of the fence" on the attached plan.

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last ten years. The erection of the fence, surrounding the front garden of 1 The Maltings, is detrimental to the character and appearance of the Malmesbury Conservation Area and, if retained, would set an undesirable precedent for similar development in the vicinity, contrary to Policy B2 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan and Policy RB3 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan Review.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- a) Take down the fence.
- b) Remove all fencing and other resultant materials from the land.
