3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission, materially changing the use of the building from a B1 Business purpose to a Fitness Clinic (Class D2 as defined in the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987).

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- a) It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last ten years.
- b) The use of the building as a Fitness Clinic is detrimental to the amenity of nearby residential properties by reason of the harm to adjoining dwellings from noise and disturbance caused by the operation of the Fitness Clinic particularly its operation outside normal working hours.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

To cease the use of the building as a Fitness Clinic (Class D2 as defined in the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987).

Four months from the date this notice takes effect.

7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 22 December 2003 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.


YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL
