1. THIS NOTICE is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, within paragraph (a) of section 171A(1) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. 2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

Land at Callands, New Road, Purton SN5 4HF shown hatched on the attached plan.

3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission, the material change of use of the property from a dwellinghouse (Class C3) to a mixed use comprising a dwellinghouse (Class C3) and an office (Class B1). Reference to classes of use refers to definitions contained in the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- a) It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last ten years.
- b) The incorporation of an office use at the premises has an unacceptable impact on the amenity of properties in the neighbourhood, contrary to Policy RE20 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan 2001.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

Cease using the land for the purposes of an office (Class B1)

6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

Six months from the date the notice takes effect.

7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 2 April 2004 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

You can appeal against this notice, but any appeal must be received, or posted in time to be **received**, by the First Secretary of State **before** the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice. - (a) One is for you to send to the Secretary of State if you decide to appeal, together with a copy of this enforcement notice.
- (b) The second copy of the appeal form should be sent to the Council.
- (c) The third copy is for your own records.

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOT APPEAL

If you do not appeal against this enforcement notice, it will take effect on the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice and you must then ensure that the required steps for complying with it, for which you may be held responsible, are taken within the period specified in paragraph 6 of the notice. Failure to comply with an enforcement notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.
