ISSUED BY: North Wiltshire District Council

1. THIS NOTICE is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, within paragraph (a) of section 171A(1) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

#### 2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

Land adjacent to 37 Stone Lane, Lydiard Millicent, Swindon, Wilts SN5 3LD shown hatched on the attached plan.

## 3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission, the change of use of land from agriculture to use for motorcycle activities not associated with agricultural use.

#### 4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- a) It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last ten years.
- b) By reason of its proximity to a number of residential properties, the use of the land by motorcycles results in an unreasonable disturbance to the amenities of local residents. The development is therefore contrary to the provisions of policy RC9 of the adopted North Wiltshire Local Plan 2001
- c) The continued use of this land by motorcycles without planning permission would, in due course, lead to the unauthorised development becoming lawful. The loss of planning control over the use of this land by

motorcycles could lead to further intensification of the use to the detriment of the rural character and amenity of the area.

#### 5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- a) Cease the use of the land by motorcycles that are not used incidental to the use of the land for agricultural purposes.
- b) Remove from the land all motorcycles and associated equipment that are not incidental to the use of the land for agricultural purposes.
- c) Resume the use of the land to a grass paddock.

#### 6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

Two months from the date this notice takes effect.

#### 7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 17 August 2004 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.



They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. #### 2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

Land adjacent to 37 Stone Lane, Lydiard Millicent, Swindon, Wilts SN5 3LD shown hatched on the attached plan.

## 3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission, the carrying out of engineering operations by the laying out of a motorcycle track and re-contouring of the land to create mounds and depressions for use in connection with motorcycle activities.

#### 4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- a) It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last four years.
- b) By reason of its proximity to a number of residential properties, the laying out of a track for motorcycle activities results in unreasonable disturbance to the amenities of local residents and visual intrusion within this rural area. The development is therefore contrary to the provisions of policy RC9 of the adopted North Wiltshire Local Plan 2001 and detrimental to the rural character and amenity of the area.

#### 5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- a) Remove all hardsurfacing materials to a depth of one metre or to the total depth of the hardsurfacing material if less than one metre.
- b) Restore the site level with the natural contours of the land over the whole of the land by the removal of all mounds, bunds and other areas where material rises above natural ground level and filling of all depressions below natural ground level with soil.
- c) Remove all hardsurfacing material and debris resulting from compliance with the requirements in paragraph 5a) from the site and also any surplus soil resulting from compliance with paragraph 5b) of the notice from the site.
- d) Finish the surface of the land with topsoil to a depth of at least 100mm over the area disturbed by the need to comply with the requirements in paragraphs 5a), 5b) and 5c) of this notice.
- e) Sow grass seed over the whole of the restored areas.

#### 6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

Four months from the date this notice takes effect.

#### 7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 17 August 2004 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.
