
### SCHEDULE 3 - REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE


### SCHEDULE 3 - STEPS REQUIRED TO BE TAKEN TO REMEDY THE BREACH

- c) Install, in place of the right hand side (when looking at the building from the street) UPVC window, a window constructed of timber to the specification and detailing shown on the attached drawing (drawing number BET.MAL.4/155/01/002).











Proposed Window Section A-A Scale 1:5
