### **ENFORCEMENT NOTICE**

ISSUED BY: North Wiltshire District Council

1. THIS NOTICE is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, within paragraph (a) of section 171A(1) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

#### 2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

Part Ordnance Survey parcel no. 3015, Hilmarton, Calne, Wiltshire shown hatched on the attached plan.

## 3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Not in accordance with conditions applied to the grant of planning permission reference 02.00471.FUL dated 19<sup>th</sup> June 2002 and therefore without planning permission, the carrying out of engineering operations on the land involving tipping which has changed the contours of the land and involved depositing materials other then soil on the site.

#### 4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- a) It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last 4 years.
- b) The development is situated in the countryside where development is strictly controlled in the interests of protecting the rural character and appearance of the area. The operations have involved the raising of land higher than appears natural and involved depositing waste, hardcore and other items in addition to soil resulting in an unsatisfactory appearance of the site contrary to Policy RC9 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan.
- c) By reason of the deposit of waste, hardcore, wood, plastic and other items and materials in addition to soil the site has little or no likelihood of being restored to a beneficial agricultural use to the detriment of the rural character of the countryside in this area.

#### 5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- Cease depositing any waste, hardcore, wood, plastic or other items or materials other than soil on the land.
- b) Screen to a depth of at least 1 metre the tipped material to extract all waste, hardcore, wood, plastic and other items and materials from the soil.
- c) Remove all waste, hardcore, wood, plastic and other items and materials resulting from requirement b) above from the site.
- d) Finish the levels of the site in accordance with the attached plan.
- e) Finish the surface of the land with topsoil to a depth of at least 75mm over the whole site except for the area of the vehicular access and turning space shown on the attached plan.
- f) Sow grass seed over the whole of the site except for the area of the vehicular access and turning space shown on the attached plan sufficient to restore the site suitable for the grazing of animals or the production of hay.

#### 6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

- a) For requirement a) of this notice 1 week from the date this notice takes effect.
- b) For requirements b) and c) of this notice 4 months from the date this notice takes effect.

c) For requirements d), e) and f) 5 months from the date this notice takes effect.

#### 7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2004 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.


#### YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

- (a) One is for you to send to the Secretary of State if you decide to appeal, together with a copy of this enforcement notice.
- (b) The second copy of the appeal form should be sent to the Council.
- (c) The third copy is for your own records.

#### WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOT APPEAL

If you do not appeal against this enforcement notice, it will take effect on the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice and you must then ensure that the required steps for complying with it, for which you may be held responsible, are taken within the period specified in paragraph 6 of the notice. Failure to comply with an enforcement notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.
