ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

ISSUED BY: North Wiltshire District Council

1. THIS NOTICE is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, within paragraph (a) of section 171A(1) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

Land at The Whole Hog, 8 Market Place, Malmesbury, Wiltshire SN16 9AS shown hatched on the attached plan.

3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission, the construction of a decking area and the insertion, within the building, of a doorway to gain access to this decking area.

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- a) It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last four years.
- b) The decking area causes loss of privacy to the adjoining neighbours and therefore is contrary to Policy RH14 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan.
- c) The inserted door, due to its position and materials, does not harmonise with the character or appearance of the existing building and the character of the Conservation Area and is therefore contrary to Policies RH14 and RB3 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- a) Demolish the decking area.
- b) Remove all debris resulting from the demolition of the decking area from the premises.
- c) Remove the door and frame from which access is gained to the decking area.
- d) Block up the resultant opening created by complying with requirement 5c) of this notice.
- e) Externally finish the blocked up area referred to in requirement 5d) of this notice with render to match the type and texture of the adjoining walls.
- f) Externally paint the finished render required by 5d) of this notice in the colour of and to match the adjoining walls.

6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

5a) and 5b) – one month from the date this notice takes effect.

5c), 5d) 5e) and 5f) - three months from the date this notice takes effect.

7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 25 June 2004 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

ANNEX

YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOT APPEAL

If you do not appeal against this enforcement notice, it will take effect on the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice and you must then ensure that the required steps for complying with it, for which you may be held responsible, are taken within the period specified in paragraph 6 of the notice. Failure to comply with an enforcement notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.
