Should you wish to appeal against the enforcement notice on ground (a) as provided by Section 174 (2)(a) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) the following fees will be required:-

£265 for both The Planning Inspectorate and the Local Planning Authority

IMPORTANT - THIS COMMUNICATION AFFECTS YOUR PROPERTY

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 (as amended by the Planning and Compensation Act 1991)

ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

ISSUED BY: North Wiltshire District Council

1. THIS NOTICE is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, within paragraph (a) of section 171A(1) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

Land at Lower Farm, Stoke Common Lane, Purton Stoke, Purton, Wiltshire SN5 4LL shown hatched on the attached plan (the land).

3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission, the material change of use of the land from agriculture to a mixed use comprising a caravan site for residential purposes and for storage of such items as vehicles, trailers, caravans, machinery, scrap, waste items, household items, timber and building materials,

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- a) It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last 10 years.
- b) The use of the land as a residential caravan site constitutes the provision of additional dwelling accommodation in the countryside where residential development is strictly controlled. The continued siting and use of the land as a caravan site is contrary to Policy RH16 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan

2001, Policy DP15 of the Wiltshire Structure Plan 2011 and Policies C3 and H4 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan 2011 revised deposit draft.

- c) The unauthorised development is situated in the countryside where development is strictly controlled in the interests of protecting the rural character and appearance of the area. The use of the land for the siting of a residential caravan and for unrestricted storage purposes, that includes open storage and associated activities, is detrimental to the rural character of the area contrary to policies DP1 and DP15 of the Wiltshire Structure Plan, Policy RC9 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan and Policies C3 and NE15 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan 2011 revised deposit draft.
- d) The development includes a commercial use of open land outside of existing buildings in the countryside contrary to the provisions of Policy RE19 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan and Policy BD5 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan 2011 revised deposit draft.
- e) The continued use of this land for the siting of a caravan and its residential use and the unrestricted use of the land for storage purposes would, in due course, lead to the unauthorised development being lawful. The loss of planning control over the use of this site for the siting of a residential caravan and for storage purposes could result in a significant intensification of use, which would further harm the rural character of the area and thereby lead to further adverse visual detriment to the rural character of the area.
- f) The development is located remote from services and employment opportunities and is unlikely to be well served by public transport and is therefore contrary to the key aims of Planning Policy Guidance Note 13, which seeks to reduce growth in the length and numbers of motorised journeys.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- a) Cease using the land as a caravan site.
- b) Remove from the land all caravans together with any ancillary works or structures.
- c) Cease the use of the land for storage.
- d) Remove from the land all stored items such as vehicles, trailers, caravans, machinery, scrap, waste items, household items, timber and building materials, and all other items associated with the unauthorised use of the land for storage purposes.
- e) Restore the land (including buildings) back to a state suitable for the reinstatement of its authorised use for agriculture.

6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

a) For requirements 5a) and 5b) of this notice 6 months from the date this notice takes effect.

- b) For requirements 5c), and 5d), of this notice 3 months from the date this notice takes.
- c) For requirement 5e) of this notice 6 months from the date this notice takes effect.

7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 8th September 2005 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.


YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

You can appeal against this notice, but any appeal must be received, or posted in time to be **received**, by the First Secretary of State **before** the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice. The enclosed booklet "Making your enforcement appeal" sets out your rights. The enclosed appeal forms are for your use.

- (a) One is for you to send to the Secretary of State if you decide to appeal, together with a copy of this enforcement notice.
- (b) The second copy of the appeal form should be sent to the Council.
- (c) The third copy is for your own records.

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOT APPEAL

If you do not appeal against this enforcement notice, it will take effect on the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice and you must then ensure that the required steps for complying with it, for which you may be held responsible, are taken within the period specified in paragraph 6 of the notice. Failure to comply with an enforcement notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.
