SUBJECT: Enforcement Notice at 40 Hamilton Drive, Chippenham, Wiltshire,

As you are aware on 13th November 2007, I served on you a copy of a Planning Enforcement Notice. This Notice required the reinstatement of the pavement adjacent to your property including the raising of the newly created drop kerb, with materials to match the adjoining pavement.

ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

ISSUED BY: North Wiltshire District Council

1. THIS NOTICE is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, within paragraph (a) of section 171A(1) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

Land at 40 Hamilton Drive, Chippenham, Wiltshire, shown hatched on the attached plan ("the Land").

3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission, the formation of a vehicular access onto the highway.

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- a) It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last four years.
- b) The development results in vehicles entering and leaving the highway at a location where visibility is restricted which is considered to be detrimental to highway safety and contrary to policy C3 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan 2011.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

a) Reinstate the pavement including the raising of the newly created drop kerb, with materials to match the adjoining pavement.

6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

Three months from the date this Notice takes effect.

7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 23rd May 2008 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.


YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

- (a) One is for you to send to the Secretary of State if you decide to appeal, together with a copy of this enforcement notice.
- (b) The second copy of the appeal form should be sent to the Council.
- (c) The third copy is for your own records.

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOT APPEAL

If you do not appeal against this enforcement notice, it will take effect on the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice and you must then ensure that the required steps for complying with it, for which you may be held responsible, are taken within the period specified in paragraph 6 of the notice. Failure to comply with an enforcement notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.
