THIS NOTICE is served by the Council, under section 187A of the above Act, because it considers that a condition imposed on a grant of planning permission, relating to the land described paragraph 2 below, is not being complied with. 4. THE BREACH OF CONDITION.

The following condition has not been complied with:

(4) No development shall take place until a report evaluating the effects of the development on the stability of the buildings, walls and land surrounding the site, and proposing any measures necessary to ensure their stability is maintained during and after development, has been prepared by a chartered structural engineer and approved in writing by the local planning authority. The development shall be carried out in accordance with any scheme so approved.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

As the person responsible for the breach of condition detailed in paragraph 4 of this Notice, you are required to comply with the stated condition by taking the following steps:

- b) Carry out works in accordance with the proposed measures referred to in paragraph 5a) above to the satisfaction of the Council as evidenced in writing.

- 5b) One month from the date of this Notice.


