ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

ISSUED BY: North Wiltshire District Council

1. THIS NOTICE is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, within paragraph (a) of section 171A(1) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

Land at Nables Farm, Upper Seagry, Chippenham, Wiltshire, shown hatched on the attached plan ("the Land").

3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission, the erection of a building situated on the Land, shown on the attached photograph AM1.

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- a) It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last four years.
- b) The building by virtue of its size and siting is a significant intrusion into the open countryside and therefore detrimental to the character and appearance of the area. The proposal is considered to be contrary to Policies NE15 and C3 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan 2011.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

a) Dismantle and remove from the Land the building, which for identification purposes only, is shown on the attached photograph, AM1.

b) Remove all materials and debris resulting from the requirements of paragraph 5a of this notice, from the Land.

6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

Two months from the date this notice takes effect.

7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 15th November 2007 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL




- (a) One is for you to send to the Secretary of State if you decide to appeal, together with a copy of this enforcement notice.

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOT APPEAL

If you do not appeal against this enforcement notice, it will take effect on the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice and you must then ensure that the required steps for complying with it, for which you may be held responsible, are taken within the period specified in paragraph 6 of the notice. Failure to comply with an enforcement notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.
