4. THE BREACH OF CONDITION.

The following conditions have not been complied with:

Condition 2: 'The development hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with the documents (including plans) incorporated into this decision, and subsequently approved pursuant to this decision (if applicable), unless otherwise approved in writing by the local planning authority..

Reason: 'To ensure that the development is implemented in accordance with this decision in the interests of public amenity'.

Condition 3 'The extension and alterations shall be constructed in accordance with the submitted plans (reference; 1b rev.e) without the balcony or French casements, as also stated in the submitted letter dated 21st July 2005. The extension shall remain in this condition thereafter.'
