



Further to your memorandum of the 2nd April, 1981, I attach for your information copies of the Enforcement Notices which have been served in connection with the above mentioned matter.







### ENFORCEMENT NOTICE



To: Mr. John Frederick Halford, Highview, Stonehill, Charlton, Nr. Halmesbury, Wiltshire

The North Wiltshire District Council (hereinafter called "the Council") being the local planning authority for the purposes of Section 87 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 in this matter HEREBY GIVE YOU NOTICE as a person **occupying** the land described in Schedule 1 hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the said land") that:-

(i) On the first day of January, 1973 outline planning permission numbered 72/UC/362/0 was granted under Pert III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 for the construction of two agricultural dwallings on land forming part of parcel 270 (Wilts. G.S. Sheet IX.9 1923) at Stonehill, Charlton, near Malmasbury in the County of Wiltshire subject to the following condition among others "The occupation of the dwallings shall be limited to persons employed or last employed wholly or mainly locally in agriculture as defined in Section 290(1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 or a dependant of such a person residing with him (but including a widow or widower of such a person)"

(ii) It appears to the Council that within a period of four years before the date of service of this notice there has been a breach of planning control in that the condition recited above has not been complied with in the respect set out in

planning control namely:To secure the discontinuance of the occupation of the said dwellinghouse by persons being neither wholly nor mainly employed or last employed locally in agriculture as defined by Section 290(1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 or a dependent

or widow or widower of such a person

THIS NOTICE SHALL TAKE EFFECT subject to the provisions of Section 88(3) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 at the end of the period of twenty eight days beginning with the oth day of June, 1981


