Reasons for issue:-

- 1. The site lies on the rural edge of Crudwell, partly within a conservation area and adjacent to residential properties where the use forms a visual intrusion detrimental to the amenities of the area.
- 2. The use by reason of the activities involved and its visual appearance forms a commercial development that is seriously detrimental to the amenities of the locality.
