- 1. To submit to the Council for approval withen one month, on a 1:500 block plan, detailed proposals for landscaping incorporating the planting of such suitable locally indigenous species of trees and hedging plants to the north east and south east of the clubhouse as will be sufficient to give the appearance of a naturally occurring screen.
- 2. After approval of the said proposals for landscaping referred to in paragraph 1 above by the Council to secure their implementation within one month of the first available planting season thereafter and maintain the same for a period of not less than five years. Any tree or hedging plant which dies within that period shall be replaced within one month of the first available planting season following the said plants demise and thereafter be maintained for a further period of five years.

ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

Calne Town Football Club Ground, Bremhill View, Calne.

WHEREAS:

- (1) It appears to the North Wiltshire District Council ("the Council") being the local planning authority for the purposes of Section 87 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 ("the Act") in this matter that there has been a breach of planning control within the period of four weeks before the day of issue of this notice on the land or premises (hereinafter referred to as "the land") described in Schedule 1 below.


