REASONS FOR ISSUE:-

1. The development involves vehicles entering, leaving, reversing turning and waiting in the carriageway of a winding section of a heavily trafficked main road (A429) to the detriment of traffic flow and road safety.
2. Due to the restricted nature of this residential curtilage in close proximity to other dwellings and their accesses the development harms local residential amenity.



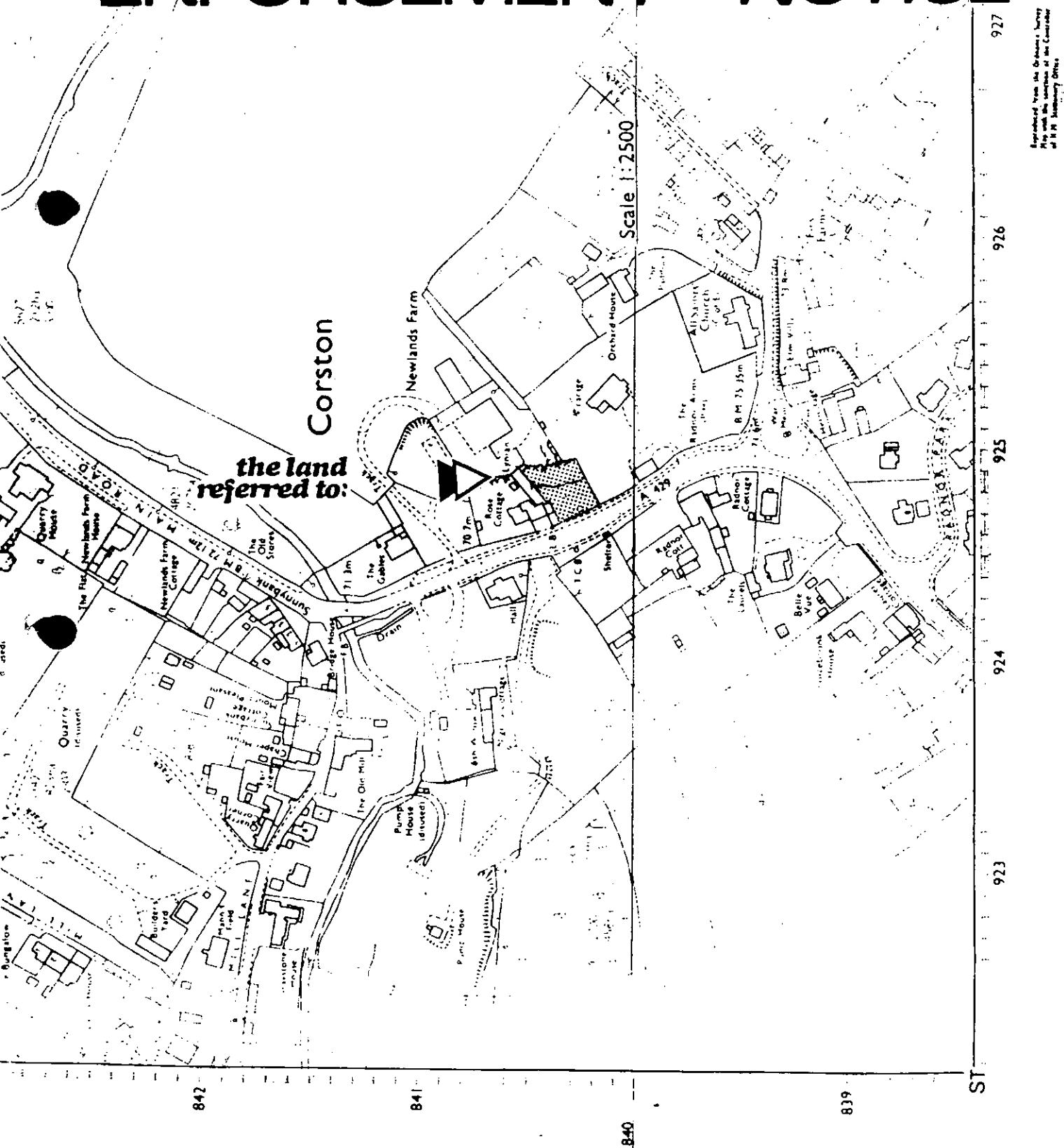
