Unauthorised works to the building consisting of:-

- 1. The dismantling of external rubble stonewall masonry to the west (front) gable above the west porch and rebuilding of the same in cement rich mortar.
- 2. The dismantling of front buttresses and rebuilding of the same at a lower hieght, with a different raking angle to the top off-sets and with different detailing to the lower off-sets to that of the original buttresses.
- 3. The raising of all external walls by a height of 500mm.



To rebuild the upper 500mm only of the external front elevation walls in natural random rubble and ashlar stonework, slightly recessed to give a "bagged" finished joint, the coursing and jointing to be in the traditional manner to match exactly with the original stonework; and the stonework shall be set in a lime putty mortar composed of 1/2 parts Portland cement: 3 parts lime putty: 12 parts sharp sand.
