

- (1) It appears to the North Wiltshire District Council ("the Council") being the local planning authority for the purposes of Section 87 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 ("the Act") in this matter, that there has been a breach of planning control within the period of four years before the date of issue of this Notice on the land or premises ("the land") described in Schedule 1 below.
- (2) The breach of planning control which appears to have taken place consists in the carrying out of the building, engineering, mining or other operations described in Schedule 2 below, without the grant of planning permission required for that development.
- (3) The Council consider it expedient, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to all other material considerations, to issue this enforcement notice, in exercise of their powers contained in the said Section 87, for the reasons set out in the ANNEX to this Notice.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council require that the steps specified in Schedule 3 below be taken in order to remedy the breach within the period of __TWO MONTHS from the date on which this Notice takes effect.

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SCHEDULE 1 - LAND OR PREMISES TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES


Land at Wood Lane, Braydon, Purton, Wiltshire shown stipple-edged on the plan annexed hereto.

SCHEDULE 2 - ALLEGED BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

The laying of hardcore materials on the land to form a hardstanding area for vehicles and the creation of a vehicular access between the land and Wood Lane, Purton, which is an adopted highway.

SCHEDULE 3 - STEPS REQUIRED TO BE TAKEN

- (i) to remove the hardcore materials from the land and from the vehicular access; and
- (ii) to restore the land by the spreading of topsoil, and seeding with grass, sufficient to sustain the use of the land for pasture; and
- (iii) the permanent closure of the vehicular access by means of a 1 metre post and rail fence with the planting of a hedge to be contiguous with the existing hedge on either side of the access.
