- l. a covered way and extension constructed of corrugated fibre cement sheeting, plywood and glass erected on the rear south west elevation
- 2. a porch canopy in timber and stone slate erected on the north elevation in the rear courtyard  ${}^{\circ}$
- 3. a modern door inserted into the south east elevation, facing The  $\,$  Hill.
