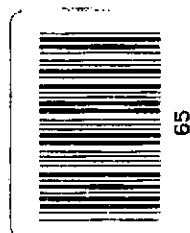


WHEREAS :

- (1) It appears to the North Wiltshire District Council ("the Council") being the local planning authority for the purposes of Section 87 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 ("the Act") in this matter, that there has been a breach of planning control within the period of four years before the date of issue of this Notice on the land or premises ("the land") described in Schedule 1 below.
- (2) The breach of planning control which appears to have taken place consists in the failure to comply with conditions or limitations subject to which planning permission was granted, that permission and the relevant condition being more fully described in Schedule 2 below.
- (3) The Council consider it expedient, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to all other material considerations, to issue this enforcement notice, in exercise of their powers contained in the said Section 87, for the reasons set out in the ANNEX to this Notice.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council require that the steps specified in Schedule 3 below be taken in order to remedy the breach within the period of two months from the date on which this Notice takes effect.

To reduce the height of vehicle bodies and other scrap material on the land to six feet.

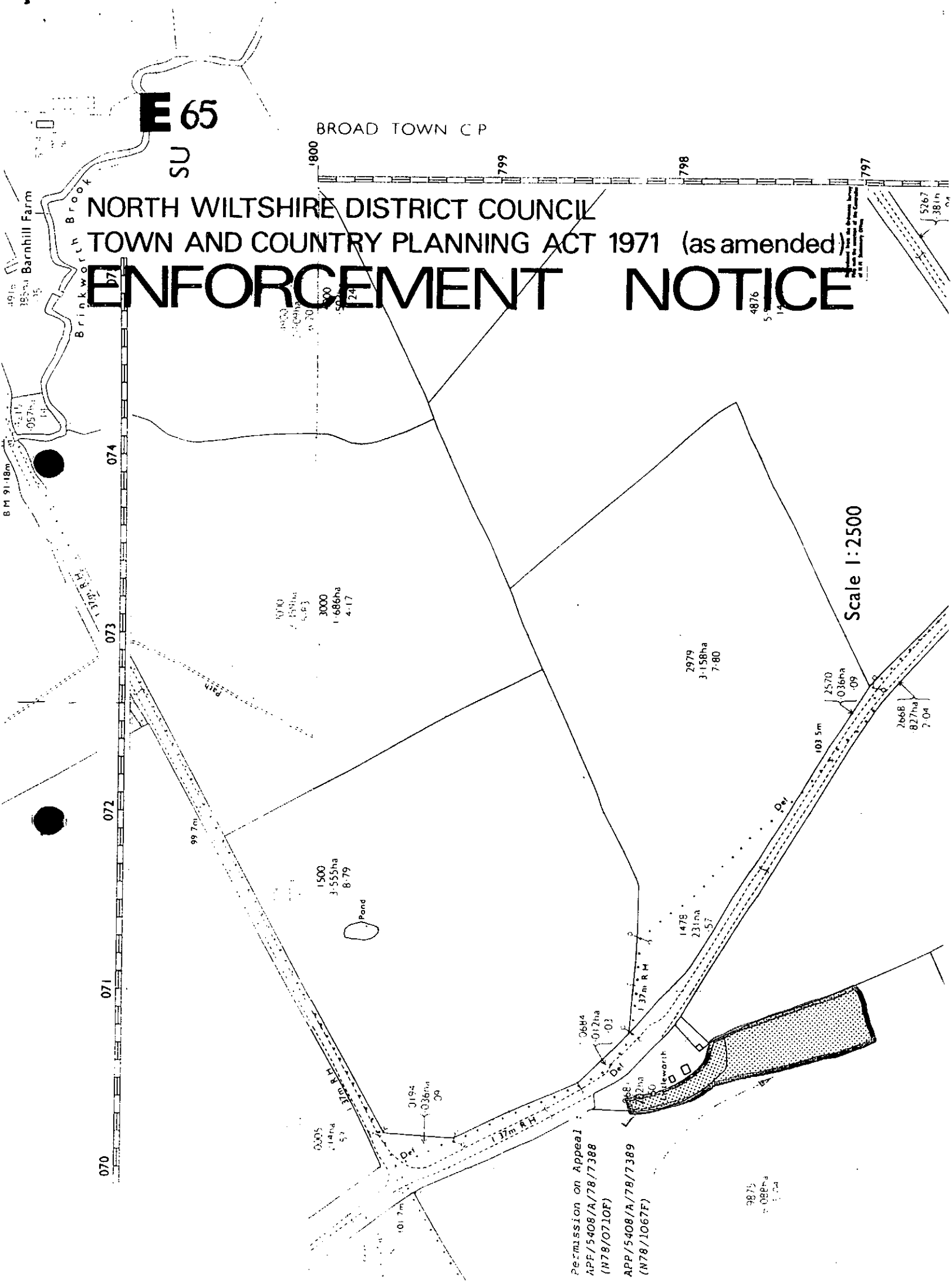

WHEREAS :

- (1) It appears to the North Wiltshire District Council ("the Council") being the local planning authority for the purposes of Section 172 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act") in this matter, that there has been a breach of planning control after the end of 1963 on the land or premises ("the land") described in Schedule 1 below.
- (2) The breach of planning control which appears to have taken place consists in the carrying out of development by the making of the material change in the use of the land described in Schedule 2 below, without the grant of planning permission required for that development.
- (3) The Council consider it expedient, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to all other material considerations, to issue this enforcement notice, in exercise of their powers contained in the said Section 172, for the reasons set out below.

SCHEDULE 1 - LAND OR PREMISES TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES

Land situated on the south western side of the C15 Wootton Bassett to Bushton road at part of O.S. parcel 9875 and part of O.S. parcel 681 "Littleworth" Bushton in the parish of Clyffe Pypard shown stipple-edged on the attached Plan A (hereinafter referred to as "the land")

SCHEDULE 2 - ALLEGED BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

The making of a material change in the use of the land from agricultural use to a continued use for that purpose and in addition use for the storage and dismantling of vehicles in connection with use of the adjacent site cross-hatched on the attached plan B at part of O.S. parcel 9875 and a vehicle dismantlers' site and scrapyard and of the adjacent site at part of O.S. parcel 681 as a vehicle dismantlers' site and retail scrap-yard for which planning permission was granted (on appeal - ref. APP/5408/A178/7388 and 9) on 3rd November 1978.

SCHEDULE 3 - STEPS REQUIRED TO BE TAKEN

- (1) To discontinue the use of the land for the storage and dismantling of vehicles
- (2) To remove or secure the removal of the said vehicles or parts of vehicles from the land
- (3) To restore or secure the restoration of the land to a condition suitable for the purposes of agriculture

STATEMENT OF REASONS WHY THE LOCAL AUTHORITY CONSIDER IT EXPEDIENT TO ISSUE THIS NOTICE

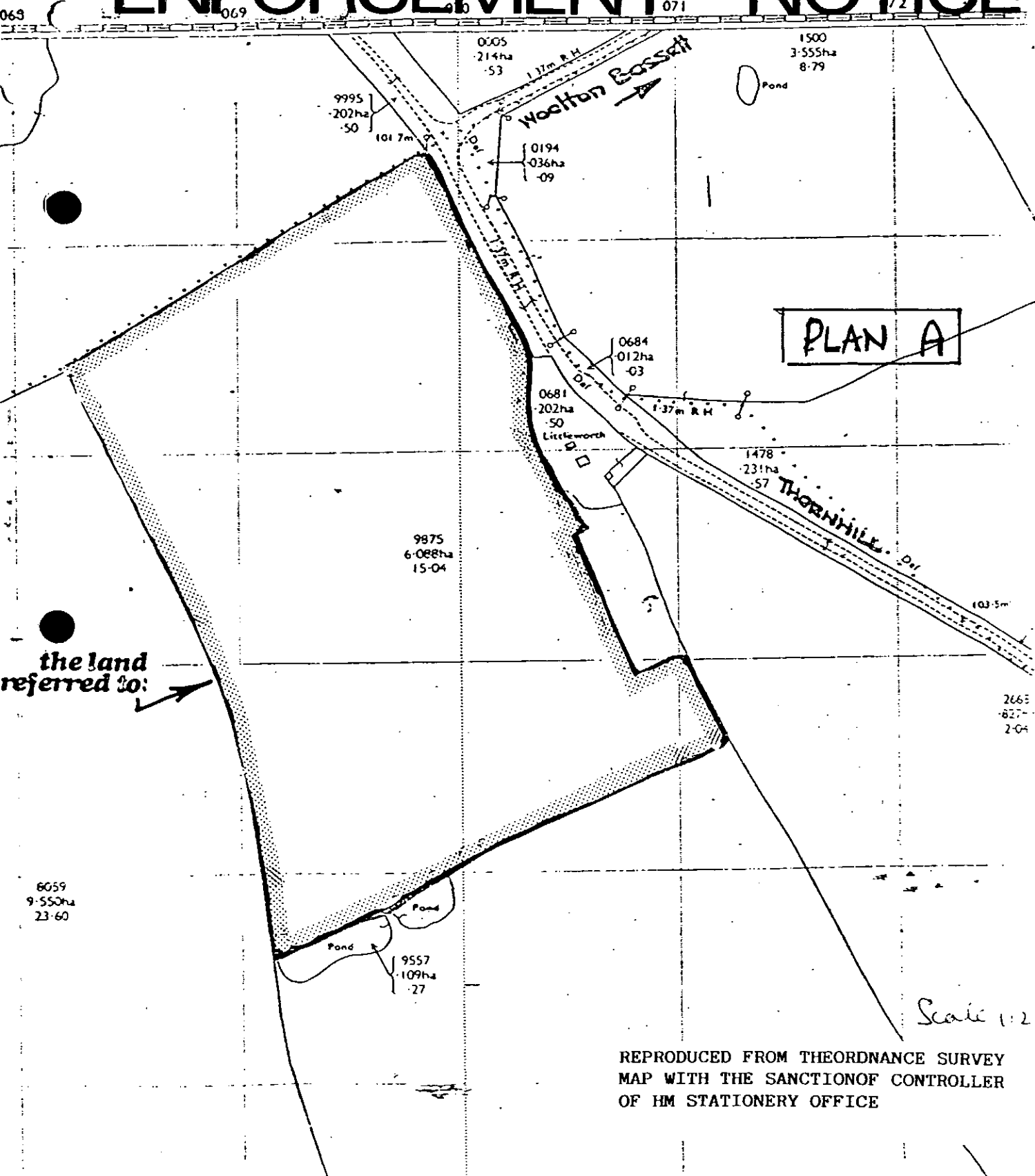
The site is situated within an attractive rural landscape where it is Central Government Policy and the Planning Authority's Policy to restrict new development (including the change of use of land) to that required in connection with agriculture or forestry or other uses appropriate to the rural area.

It is considered the unauthorised expansion of this site is unacceptable and the use is unsuitable, inappropriate and visually intrusive in this rural area and should be carried out in a suitable location within or attached to an existing urban area or on land specifically authorised or allocated for such a commercial use.

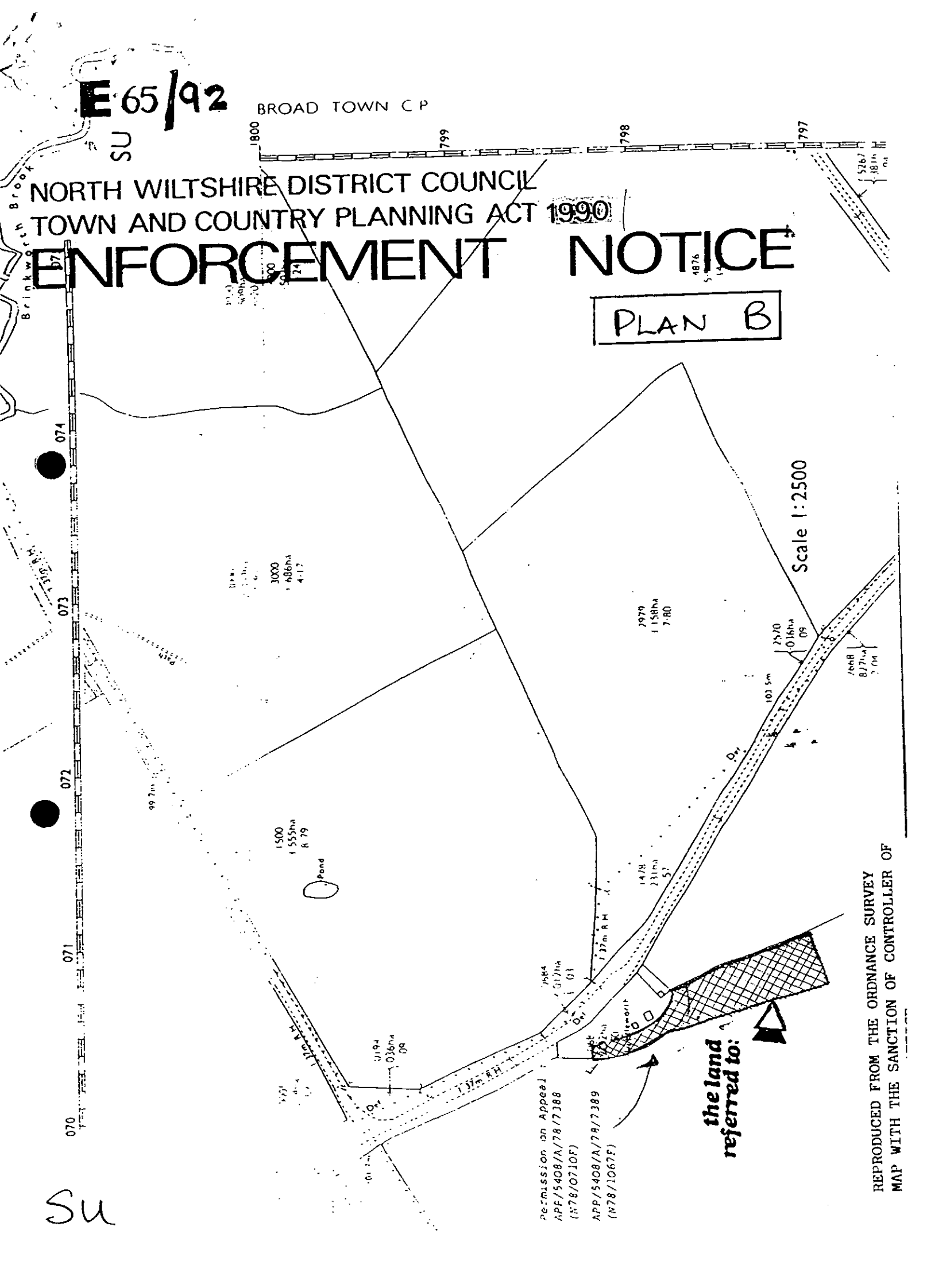

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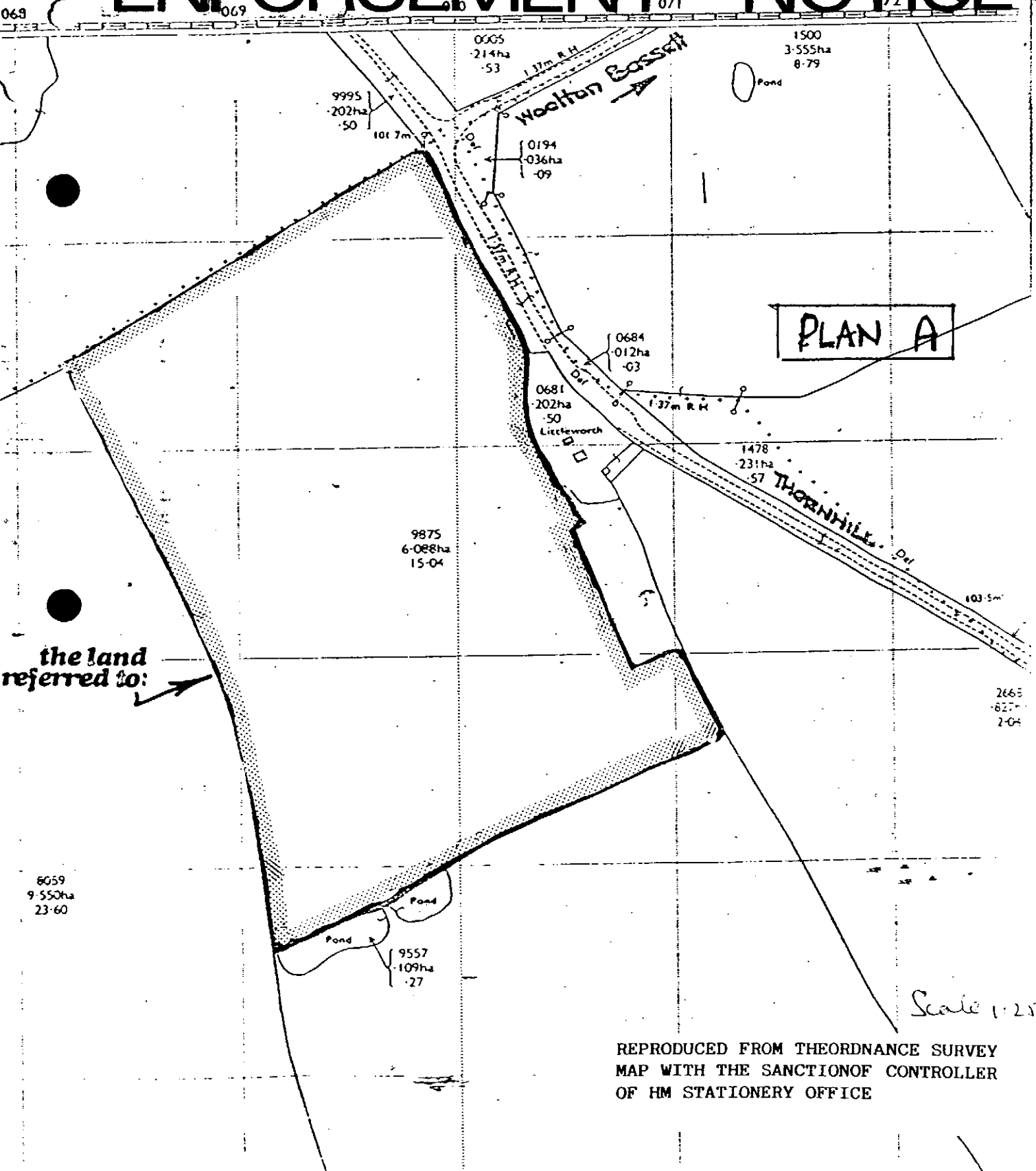
