



Unless an appeal is made to the Secretary of State as described below, the Notice will take effect on the date shown in the box below and you must then ensure that the required steps for which you may be held responsible are taken within the period or periods specified in the Notice.

If you wish to appeal against the Notice, you should first read carefully the enclosed booklet entitled "Enforcement Notice Appeals - A Guide to Procedure". Then, you or your agent should complete the enclosed appeal form and send it, together with the extra copy of the Enforcement Notice enclosed herewith to the address on the appeal form. Your appeal MUST BE RECEIVED by the Department of the Environment BEFORE THE NOTICE TAKES EFFECT.

There is a requirement on the Council to specify the reasons why the local planning authority consider it expedient to issue the Notice and these reasons are set out in the ANNEX overleaf.

ANNEX - (This does not form part of the enforcement notice)

Reasons for issue:-

1. The use of the land as a builders' yard, by reason of the generation of commercial vehicle movements along a narrow unmade track, caused inconvenience and danger to existing pedestrian, horse and agricultural uses.
2. The use of the site for outside storage is severely detrimental to the visual amenities of the countryside which should be protected for its own sake.
3. The use of the site as a builders' yard by reason of the scale and character of the existing building and the location of the site in the open countryside will be detrimental to the character of the countryside and amenities of the local environment.
4. The site by reason of its size and because of the nature of this particular building business, will be likely to be the subject of pressure for expansion and related proposals and such activities will compound the above problems and be severely detrimental to visual amenity and to the character of the countryside. The development would be likely to create a severe precedent for those pressures on the site and on other sites in the locality.
5. The development is contrary to Policies E14 and E16 of the Western Wiltshire Structure Plan and Policies E13 and E14 of the Draft North Wiltshire Local Plan 1990 which seek to:
  - (a) direct employment sites to preferred locations where effects on the character and amenities of the countryside and highway safety are acceptable;
  - (b) restrict open storage uses to areas within towns or villages, and,
  - (c) restrict the change of use of buildings in the countryside to those which are compatible with the environment in which they are located.



SCHEDULE 1 - LAND OR PREMISES TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES

Land at Abberd Lane, Calne, Wiltshire shown stipple-edged on the attached plan

SCHEDULE 2 - ALLEGED BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

- (a) The laying of hard core materials on the land to form a hardstanding area for vehicles and skips.
- (b) Construction of an earth ramp for use in connection with a skip waste transfer station and the widening of the access onto the site and the erection of metal security gates.

SCHEDULE 3 - STEPS REQUIRED TO BE TAKEN

- 1. To remove the hard core materials from the land; and
- 2. To restore the access to its appearance and size immediately prior to the operations described in Schedule 2 above and to remove the security metal gates; and
