To remove from the land the gravel and materials forming the hardstanding; to grade the land to the levels existing before the engineering operation took place with top soil and to grass seed the land

STATEMENT OF REASONS WHY THE LOCAL PLANNING AUTHORITY CONSIDER IT EXPEDIENT TO ISSUE THIS NOTICE

The loose gravel surface and hardstanding which has been laid for the purpose of displaying motor vehicles amounts to an expansion of the existing garage service station in a prominent roadside site within the countryside which is of recognised scenic quality and part of the wider North Wessex Downs Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. The expansion of the garage and the appearance of vehicles on the site and the general activity associated with such a use is severely detrimental to the visual amenity of the area and contrary to policy C3B of the Western Wiltshire Structure Plan Incorporating Allocation Number One and policies E13,C3 and C7 of the emerging North Wiltshire Local Plan 1990.
