- The insertion of glazed screens in the openings to the central bays of the north and south elevations and to the south elevations of the single-storey extension.

SCHEDULE 3 - STEPS REQUIRED TO BE TAKEN

- To remove the internal partitions from the central bay of the building
 To restore the building to its former state
- 2. To remove the said screens
- 3. To replace the said screens with new glazed screens to the following specification:
 - (a) each screen to be subdivided by moulded timber mullions into five equal glazed areas
 - (b) the screen to the north elevation to have a transom at a height of 2.5 metres
