The Council have issued an Enforcement Notice relating to the above land and I now serve on you a copy of that Notice, in view of your interest in the land. Unless an appeal is made to the Secretary of State as described below, the Notice will take effect on the date shown in the box below and you must then ensure that the required steps for which you may be held responsible are taken within the period or periods specified in the Notice.

WHEREAS :

- (1) It appears to the North Wiltshire District Council ("the Council") being the local planning authority for the purposes of Section 172 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act") in this matter, that there has been a breach of planning control within the period of four years before the date of issue of this Notice on the land or premises ("the land") described in Schedule 1 below.
- (2) The breach of planning control which appears to have taken place consists in the carrying out of the building, engineering, mining or other operations described in Schedule 2 below, without the grant of planning permission required for that development.
- (3) The Council consider it expedient, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to all other material considerations, to issue this enforcement notice, in exercise of their powers contained in the said Section 172, for the reasons set out below.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council require that the steps specified in Schedule 3 below be taken in order to remedy the breach within the period of ONE MONTH from the date on which this Notice takes effect.

Land to the south west of Coffin Lane, Kington Langley, shown stipple-edged on the attached plan


The tipping of soil and subsoil on the land

SCHEDULE 3 - STEPS REQUIRED TO BE TAKEN

- (i) To remove the tipped soil and subsoil from the land; and
- (ii) To restore the land to its condition and levels immediately prior to when the tipping operations began

STATEMENT OF REASONS WHY THE LOCAL AUTHORITY CONSIDER IT EXPEDIENT TO ISSUE THIS NOTICE

- The site is situated in a Conservation Area. Some of the tipped soil has been piled up, but some of the soil has been spread around the boundaries of the adjacent development of 2 dwellings at Parkers Lane, creating artificial scarp slopes in a location clearly visible from the bridleway (No.36) to the north and west.
- 2. The tipping has taken place around nine Lombardy Poplar trees and one Ash tree and hedge consisting mainly of holly, hazel, hawthorn and blackthorn. The raising of the ground level and the use of heavy plant to spread the soil and subsoil is likely to compact the soil around the roots of the trees thus interrupting the essential supply of air, water and nutrients to the roots which could lead to a decline in the vigour of the trees.
- 3. The scarp slopes, raised land and the adverse effect on the boundary trees and hedges is detrimental to the character and visual appearance of the country-side and the Conservation Area.

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
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
