





Land at Castle Combe Golf Course, Castle Combe, Wiltshire, shown stipple-edged on the attached plan

SCHEDULE 2 - ALLEGED BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

The carrying out of development without the required planning permission consisting of operations on the said land, namely works of excavation and cutting, and subsequent laying of crushed limestone and/or ballast, to create a continuous linear track (known as a "buggy track") varying in width from 2.4 metres to 3 metres, and running over a distance of approximately 215 metres, in the approximate position shown by a broken black line and marked "The Works referred to " on the attached plan

SCHEDULE 3 - STEPS REQUIRED TO BE TAKEN

- 1. To remove the crushed limestone and ballast materials from the track to the extent necessary to comply with step 2 hereof
- 2. To restore the land to the condition it was in immediately prior to the development referred to in Schedule 2 above by reforming a surface graded into the adjacent track edges by the use and introduction of top soil to a depth of not less than 100 mm.
- 3. To seed all the restored areas with the following seed mix and to the following specification:

Seed mix

Strong turfgrass mixture, either 10% Agrostis castellana:50% festuca rubra ssp purinosa : 20% Lolium perenne : 20% Poa pratensis, or such other mixture as may be approved beforehand in writing by the Council

Specification

Work in organic element such as lignite to prepared top soil. Apply pre-seed fertiliser 10:15:10 NPK. Apply seed. Apply slow-release fertiliser after two weeks.

To remedy the breach by restoring the land to its condition before the breach took place

STATEMENT OF REASONS WHY THE LOCAL PLANNING AUTHORITY CONSIDER IT EXPEDIENT TO ISSUE THIS NOTICE

The works of excavation and cutting and the subsequent creation of a track in crushed limestone and ballast has introduced a strong linear scar into a very attractive and publicly visible landscape, to the severe detriment of visual amenity.





- (3) The Council consider it expedient, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to all other material considerations, to issue this enforcement notice, in exercise of their powers contained in the said Section 172, for the reasons set out below.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council require that the steps specified in Schedule 3 below be taken in order to remedy the breach within the period of THREE MONTHS from the date on which this Notice takes effect.

THIS NOTICE SHALL TAKE EFFECT, subject to the provisions of Section 175(4) of the Act, on 25th October 1993

SCHEDULE 1 - LAND TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES

Land at Hunter's Lodge Farm, Draycot Cerne, Chippenham, Wiltshire shown edged by a broken black line on the attached plan.

SCHEDULE 2 ALLEGED BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

The making of a material change in the use of the land from agricultural use to a continuing use for that purpose and in addition, use for the stationing of a mobile home for the purposes of providing residential accommodation and domestic storage.

SCHEDULE 3 - STEPS REQUIRED TO BE TAKEN

- 1. To cease the use of the land for the stationing of a mobile home for the purpose of providing residential accommodation and domestic storage, and
- 2. To remove from the land the said mobile home.

REASONS FOR ISSUE

It is considered that the mobile home is detrimental to the character of the countryside and should a planning application have been made it would have been recommended for refusal for the following reason:-
