WHEREAS:

- (1) It appears to the North Wiltshire District Council ("the Council") being the local planning authority for the purposes of Section 172 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act") in this matter, that there has been a breach of planning control within the last ten years on the land or premises ("the land") described in Schedule 1 below.
- (2) The breach of planning control which appears to have taken place consists in the carrying out of development by the making of the material change in the use of the land described in Schedule 2 below, without the grant of planning permission required for that development.
- (3) The Council consider it expedient, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to all other material considerations, to issue this enforcement notice, in exercise of their powers contained in the said Section 172, for the reasons set out below.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council require that the steps specified in Schedule 3 below be taken in order to remedy the breach within the period of Six months from the date on which this Notice takes effect.

Schedule 2 - ALLEGED BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL


Unauthorised material change of use of part of the disused airfield for the composting, storing and size-grading of wood based materials.

Schedule 3 - STEPS TO BE TAKEN

- (1) Cease to use the land for the composting, storing and size-grading of wood based materials.
- (2) To remove the wood based materials stored on the land referred to and all machinery associated with the unauthorised use:

REASONS FOR ISSUE

- (1) The use of a long length of former aircraft runway/taxiway curving across an open field adjacent to the Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and visible from close by and seen on the skyline from the B4014 Malmesbury to Tetbury road adversely affects the amenities and rural character of the area conflicting with policy C7 of the North Wiltshire Local Plan.
- (2) The continued use of this land for the unauthorised storage and activities would set a serious precedent for the expansion of the use onto adjacent former aircraft runways to the further detriment of the visual amenities in this area and rural amenity in general.

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
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
