





ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

I refer to my letter to you of 7 November 1995 in which I informed you that the Enforcement Notice issued against you on 28 September 1995 was to be withdrawn.

In that letter I also advised you that the Council would consider issuing a further notice against you, unless certain conditions which had been agreed with you, were complied with. These conditions were as follows:-

- 1. No more than six cars are visible on land at Tayvallich House. In other words, any car or cars kept in the garage will be excluded from the total, but there should be no more than six cars in the open air or in the car-port. This applies to any car, whatever its condition.
- 2. No car parts are stored in the open air.

These conditions were to be complied with by the end of December 1995.

I am now advised by the Chief Planning Officer that, when the site was visited on 3 January 1996, there were ten cars in the garden and on the drive, together with the boat and trailer. This is clearly not in accordance with the agreed arrangements set out above.

Accordingly, I am writing to inform you that unless you have taken the necessary steps to comply with the above conditions within ten days of the date of this letter, I shall act on my instructions to issue a further enforcement notice against you, as indicated in my earlier letter.

If you wish to discuss this matter, please contact me or Mr Evans in the Planning Department.


